SPRATLY VS5MC did get close to the island a week ago but after doing a bit of reconnoitering in the area, decided that it might be best not to attempt a landing. It seems that someone was there already and there were some buildings and masts for antennas on the island. The vessel closed to about three miles from the island and they then decided that perhaps that was close enough. There are some indications that the 1S1A operation might very well be the last Spratly operation for some time....if ever. The Peoples Republic of China have been making some strong claims to islands in the China Sea and earlier this year took over the Hsi Sha Islands from South Viet Nam by force. There was speculation in some European papers (Der Spiegel/Jan 74) that China would be moving towards other groups including the Chung Sha Islands; the Tung Sha Atoll and the Nan Sha group. This latter group is 600 miles south of Hainan, 300 miles northwest of Brunei. Spratly in the past has been referred to as the 'Nanshiao' islands and it would seem that this is possibly the Nan Sha islands referred to in the above. Anyhow, there was no action from Spratly last week and good reason why.

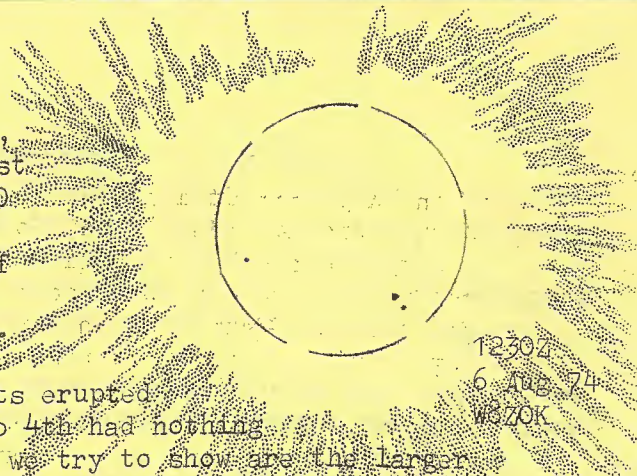
FERNANDO DE NORONHA The Brazilian group showed from the South Atlantic island group on schedule but signing PQONS and PQARM, the special calls having been issued for this effort. Otherwise all is the same as reported last week and the operation should continue until this Friday.

COCOS KEELING VK9YV continues to be active just about daily, starting around 0800Z in the 14223kc area. Generally he will be meeting with VK6WT on schedule at that time and frequency. Bill also passes along the information that he will be listening for the Western Reaches in the 1400-1600Z slot most days except Wednesdays. QSLs for this Cocos-Keeling operation go to JA2KLT.

PACIFIC ACTION Jim Henderson, WB6CZB, is presently in Western Samoa signing 5W1AL while trying to line up the plans for a possible Tokelaus operations next month. Jim has been on both c.w. and SSB and QSLs for this 5W1 action go to W5UBW. There may possibly be some word on the plans for ZM7 in the next week or so.

Mt ATHOS In spite of some diligent scouring, no late word on the Mt. Athos event has been forthcoming and there has been no further word from any of the principals in on the planning. The feeling is that it is still on though the political situation has not helped. Saturday we checked with several sources and drew a blank and no late word seems to be available. The last word was that the gear was cached in Athens and that tickets for the travel to that area had been purchased. Unfortunately the operation is scheduled for this coming weekend and there will be no chance to give any update. Here there is nothing known to indicate that the Mt. Athos effort will not come off. However, all we can advise is to watch around 14195kc this coming weekend. If they show with SV1GA/A, you should hear something.....for sure!!

SUNSPOT LOUIE This weeks chart shows two spots, the larger of which rotated into appearance last Monday, August 5th. It is approximately 15,000 miles in diameter. The smaller spot showed on the following day and is about half the size of the large sunspot, not too well defined at the time of observation and perhaps not too active. Up to the time these showed, there had been no visible sunspots since August 1st when two spots erupted and disappeared within two days. August 2nd to 4th had nothing showing. It might be kept in mind is that all we try to show are the larger spots which would have significant effect on radio propagation. There are always a number of smaller spots visible with high magnification though these may not cause noticeable improvement in the bands. Zurich will always have a higher count, these charts aim more at the significant spots that will have noticeable impact. A recurrent period of magnetic disturbance is expected over the coming weekend.

Seems that there were problems with an ever-lengthening membership and roll-call list and they decided to cool things off a bit. A lot of short-lived calls have been showing up...the "R" prefix from Russia on August 4th...the UP3ØKA on August 1st. The CY-prefixes from Quebec Province. W4EH had a tornado touch down less than a hundred yards from this QTH. George says that's close enough. Harry Dannals, W2TUK, has been nominated as a Fellow in the Radio Club of America.

The Virginia Century Club along with the Virginia Beach Radio Club will operate a special call at the 1st Annual Neptune Festival and will commence using WX4NEP on September 25th. The call should be heard until October 7th... CW will be 30kc up from band edge...SSB at 3830/7230/14280/21280/21380 and 28580kcs. QSLs to W4LRN. Speaking of tornadoes, TOWTEC makes an automatic tower control system that will lower your tower automatically if wind velocity reaches a pre-set level. W2EV will send information if you drop him a note.

We have a call for QSL info on XW8FN, VP2DM and W1NXZ. Also a call for PY6AM. Over 125 showed for dinner at the NorthWest DX gathering last week with AP2AD and YB7AAU there. And there is still chance to make the W9-DXCC meeting (W9KNI) which will be September 21st in Itasca, or the North East DX Gathering at Newton, Mass on October 12th and W1DAL will supply information if needed.

CR8AC was heard on the western reaches last week...weak signal at 14220kc/0730Z. VS5MC is reported as planning to depart Brunei for England at the end of this month while Don Riebhof (HS3DR/XU1DX etc) should arrive there about August 28th.

WA7FAB is available for DX QSL Manager chores. While WA9PZU is the QSL Manager for CT2BN who is listed in a few spots with Red Eyed. On those logs for XU1AA which were reported lost...that would be the summer period of 1973....WØHBH reports that he worked XU1AA during the lost period and recently received a XU1AA QSL via HB9OP. Live in hope.

That KS9EAA at the Experimental Aviation Assn Meeting has produced a number of variants for QSOs. We have had WA9GUY/WA9GJU and WA9JGU. We suspect that one is right but cannot tell you just which one.

This week is the first non-hecktic one we have had for over a month. Last month to cap everything the mimeograph came unstuck during the run. If strong language would have helped, we would have been home free. This week we have more time...even to the point of acknowledging some notes. However, the news level down this week. MAURITANIA 5T5GS, George Smith from Anaheim in Southern California, has been showing on twenty, his first day on air being Sunday, August 4th. The initial pile-ups startled him but after a bit he was managing well. He will be there in 5T5-land for about three years. Look for him around 14215kc/0500Z. QSL to W6KTE.

THE LONG LOOK There is an island off Antarctica which will qualify for a new country should anyone managed to get there with the gear and a good antenna. Most maps will show it as Peter I Island and you should find it on most maps.

Before leaping to your feet and packing your bags, it is another one of those islands difficult to reach and visited only on rare occasions. It has been reported that a Norwegian Scientific study group has stopped there. Some have tried to get some idea of the costs of making a trip there.....\$25K has been mentioned as an ball park figure and that might go higher.

From time to time you may hear references to a mysterious island..most likely this is it.
