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DXCC DESK Bob White, W1CW, was moved upstairs to the ARRL QSL Bureau on September 1st and Dave Newkirk, WA1VCG, is now holding down the furniture. The move was not just figuratively and W1CW will be organizing things for the OUTGOING QSL Bureau which will open in a month or so.

On the QSLs, it is reported that the 7J1RL cards are being accepted for DXCC credit, and that a decision on the D6A activity should be heard shortly. While no indication has been given as to what the decision will be, the feeling is that it will be in favor of D6A as a new country.

No decision is evidenced on STØ or WG1JFK and these two appear to be still under study.

Looking a bit into the future, it does appear that Transkei has an excellent chance for being a 'new'one when that homeland attains independence in late October. It is also possible that if the WG1JFK is accepted as a new one, that there are other areas around the world in the same category.

THE BIG QRM Another view on the Big QRM has come and this one expresses the feeling that this may not necessary be a jamming signal

Perry Esten, W6PN, points out that generally the Soviet or Eastern Europe bloo jammers usually use modern transmitters with excellent frequency atability. While sometimes FM or Wobble Tone modulation is used and broadness due to the high fields laid down in the jamming target areas, the signals are usually relatively sharp and do not QRM much more than about 10kc-wide bands.

W6PN expresses the feeling that the QRM may be connected with propagation monitoring or ranging. He feels that the characteristics that one would encounter in such service are there, noting that it should like a pulse of about 1 millisecond, overmodulated with about a 5khz tone.

Usually jamming signals are designed to obliterate, if possible, single channels which are carrying programming offensive to the regime doing the jamming. In Europe the h.f broadcast bands are 5khz wide while in the m.f. bands the channels are 9khz wide. Often harmonics from jamming efforts are heard elsewhere in the the bands.

W6PN speculates that if this really were to be jamming, it would probably not be for the purpose of blocking h.f. communications, as usually defined, but would be for a wide-band service and there is no knowledge of any such wide-band service in the h.f. spectrum.

From familiarity with pulsed transmissions for propagation studies and back-scatter ranging in the h.f. broadcast bands, the characteristics of these being quite different from jammer transmissions, W6PN speculates that the QRM may be associated with a Soviet propagation studies of some kind.

W6PN, Perry Esten, was the Director of Engineering for RADIO FREE EUROPE with his headquarters based in Munich prior to his retirement.

W2AG, Bob Ehrler, ex-W2CTO, notes that the signal continues to be heard, it being bad on the first 100khz of twenty on September 4th and around 1945Z was taking out everything.

SUNSPOT LOUIE Last Tuesday there were two active areas visible on the sun's surface, one area with a large single spot but covering 170/millions of the surface was at 16°N and 40°W. This was the same spot as shown on last weeks chart, showing first as it came into view on the eastern limb on August 29th. It has maintained it's sixe during the time it has been in sight, being as high in area as 190/millionths on some days.

Closer to the equator another area showed on September 5th and on the 7th was showing two spots and covering but 1/millionth of the surface.

During the last week or so, conditions have been on the edge of being sither duiet or unsettled. WWV was looking at the possibility of a moderate possibility of some SWFs but saying that the chances were one in ten of it happening. However, looking ahead a bit they do say there is a possibility of a minor ionospheric storm starting this coming Sunday and running to September 22nd.

Set

During the latter part of August, from the 19th to 31st, there were four active regions on the sun, the most active one turned up its toes on August 29th and this also was what happened to one of the less-active ones. All of these were old Cycle 20 activity.

The turn is still marked for a happening sometime in 1977 if you believe all the experts...like Dr. Waldmeier at Zurich, WWV at Boulder and Dr Cohen there in Alexandria, Virginia on the south bank of the Potomac. All you have to do is hang on long enough and all the rewards due a Deserving DXer will come your way.

But with the turn programmed for 1977....remember we did say something about it coming after the elections, what will it be like next week...and the week afterwards. WAUMF takes the long look and comes up with a mixed bag. Ted says it will be:

The format on WWV has consistently been the source for the real up-date on conditions and if it goes, it will be mighty hard to replace. Don't relax and figure that any W1AW supplemental broadcasts will replace WWV....that will not fill the bill unless they go to an hourly up-date as WWV has and that hardly seems likely. Keep what you have already....write some letters.

Up from the south at break of day comes the word from K6EC on the big picture for the big chartmakers and Ev says that the big picture looked something like:

SHORTLY NOTED YS10 was in the San Francisco area to visit his daughter. Oscar phoned to find out if he was missing any choice DX. What would you tell anyone if you got a call like that?

K1AGB, Ed Meade, notes that that RØBAM being heard the last part of August and into September was the call of a railroad construction crew operating between Bam in the west Amur region and Chulxman in the southwestern Yakutsk ASSR, this being close to the Chinese border.

During the first part of this month the crew will be working north along the Tynda towards Chulxman, going via Berkakit and Neryungri. Unlike most UAØB=callsigns, this one is not north of the Arctic Circle and does not count for the RAEM award.

However, that UK1ZAA operation from Kildin island does count, islands above the Artic Circle count for five points each in the RAEM award. This UK1ZAA was being operated by UA1ABW and UA1ZX. Kilden Island is northeast or Murmansk and at the mouth of Kolskij Bay.

K1AGB does collect picture postcards of Soviet Union scenes and does have a large collection garmered from DX contacts within the USSR as well as from SWLs. Ed is looking for more material for his album and would appreciate receiving any such picture postcards that anyone might be able to spare. He does speak Russian quite fluently.....often handy when one gets a letter from Box 88 in response to a complaint over non-receipt of QSLs. K1AGB is E.L Meade, 92 Grove Street, Plainville, Mass 02762.

On those other R-calls being heard, R8SM from Samarkand was supposed to be on until Sept 10th and R8TA from Tashkent until the 14th. RØWL from Vladivostok should be heard until Sept 16th and RØBAM from the Baikal Amur in the period September 23rd and 24th. As the call was heard in August, RØBAM that is, there may be some variations. Like the 8J2HAM being heard September 5th on twenty SSB. That one was not supposed to show until later this month.

During the last couple of weeks the staff at the WCDXB has been trying to figure out how some of the new equipment works. It does seem that within the month we may be showing the results of some of the efforts. The possibility of in-house production of half-tones for pictures in the bulletin does seem very good. Just hold your breath.

One of the factors turning up in the WWV broadcast struggle is some feeling that somewhere along the line the interest in the h.f. has been downgraded. Some have even speculated that government agencies, including the military, have either a reduced or no interest in future utilization of the h.f. spectrum and it does not figure in their planning.

Like some of the flak coming up on the WWV matter. There is a feeling that with neither commercial interests or the military especially interested in the h.f. bands, any activity to assist in these areas is largely for the benefit of the amateurs.

Admittedly this is largely speculation but it has been turning up and perhaps something is there beneath the surface.

MORE SHORT NOTES We have had some letters from overseas this week. For one thing, PA9WRR figures to flee Amsterdam to make sure that he does not miss the Stanford-USC football game.

Erik Sjolund, SMØAGD, notes that the QSLs for both the Baja Nuevo and the Serrana Bank are back from the printers and SM3CXS will be pumping out QSLs at an accelerated rate. The hope was that they would all be in the mails by last weekend.

Erik expects to be in the Asia or Africa area during the period October through December and will be looking for some operations from those areas. The QSLs for their June operations are from photos taken on the trip, the one from Serrana Bank giving you a close look at what three big-gun DXers look like.....SMØAGD, HKØBKX and K6AHV.

This was another Northern California DX Foundation supported effort and there have been some inquiries, but not many, as to what the foundation might be doing.

Right now....nothing much. The feeling being that any large expenditure for any block-buster DX efforts at this time would be a chancey thing due to the current band conditions. The Foundation is thinking but feeling that it might be better to wait for the turn though any effort that looks like it would produce a good return will get some warm attention.

The Foundation probably will be making a mailing or two in the next several months to enlist more support for the organization. The basic objectives of the Foundation continues to be DX.... the more the better. They are also studying ways to make the Foundation able to operate more on a turn-over of income rather than using capital assets to finance operations. All of this may be a bit complicated but in a slow week it may give you something to consider.

Getting back to the mail, a note from Enn Lokh, UR2AR, brings the information that he has been hospitalized twice in the last year, one time for an operation. Enn notes that he has moved to a new QTH, an apartment and he will need a tower and beam to get above the array of TV antennas on the apartment house roof. UR2AR has been heard intermittently via a club station there in Tallinn, Enn for years being the Big Gun out of UR2-land and did wipe out a lot of the demand for Franz Josef in 1972 in the UK1ZF1 operation he made with UR2DW.

CR9AJ was on W7PHOs net last Tuesday, September 7th. Torres has not been reported much of late. And no word has been neard on FR7ZL who was supposed to be on Tromelin from late July. Likewise, no reports on W7LXE/Su from the Sinai Field Mission. Many are called but few are heard.

There is a report that a WA2 will be Baghdad and figures to operate. He will be there September 13th for a couple of days. Operating frequencies were to be around 14210khz. VERON reports that JH1KSB/JD1 has been heard from Ogasawara.....14045khz around 0930Z. Some PYs are also said to be aiming for CEØ-Easter Island for the last part of September. A7XA can go either direct or via DJ9ZB. VE1BFV was noted at 14197kc from 0230Z the last day or so in August...otherwise, this one from Sable Island has not been heard much of late.

JW1SO is on Bear Island....7XLMD goes to CBA....FG7AN to WA3EDS and 5N2NAS to WB9MFC. ZA1B heard at 14030kc from 1030Z on September 1st said to QSL to GLBBA. Some were suspicious of this one, the reasons not being exactly clear, but pointed questions brought rounded answers....and little information. EL2DT will be leaving Liberra the first part of September and should next surface in CN8.....the wait may be long.

EP2SE (W6FZO) is being heard from Iran. W6SJQ has also been licensed as EP2DE but has had trouble prying his gear through customs. Out of space but now news again....
