- FRENCH GUIANA P21BX expects to announce date for FY7 trip within two weeks. QSL to Box 2003 Paramaribo, Surinam, South America. From the Canadian DX Bulletin, FY7YM left for three month trip without giving VE1KG logs. Any QSL since Dec '67 will have to wait until logs arrive.
- FARQUHAR VQ9B/F showed up last Tuesday and was scheduled to secure Saturday.
- BRUNEI Time is near for VS6RCS operation from May 30-June 2nd. Again, the planned frequencies are: 14101, 21245 and 28520 transmitting, listening 14190-14220, 21255-21265 and 28530. QSL information in 2-68.
- REVILLA GIGEDO Operation in 444-land now planned for October...hoping to arrange private transportation so operations can be longer than 24 hours (VE-DX Assn)
- GRAND TURK AND CAICOS VP5CB, Charley, keeps a schedule 23003MT Fridays at 21345kc. Located on South Caicos. QSL to home call, K3NAU.
- WESTERN SAMOA 5W1AT, Trevor, keeps a schedule at O400GMT two or three times a week. Transmits 14190--1istens 14220. QSL via W4ZXI
- TRISTAN de CUNHA ZD9BE scheduled for June 1 at 1500GMT on long path on twenty. Jim, 2D82, handling the arrangements again. Around 14260kc.
- BURUNDI 905CR still showing up frequently between 21250 and 21300 or slightly above around 1900GMT. Handle is Bob. QSL to Bx 1322, Bujumbura, Burundi. Many of these lesser known countries sometimes difficult to identify by mail handlers when just country shown. It does not hurt to add additional information such as Central Africa for Burundi or West Africa for Rio Muni. The QSL information for 905SK--which did not print good in 3-68 is: K. Schillebeecks, B.P. 1358, Bujumbura, Burundi, Central Africa. Another station on from Burundi is 905SE, usually above 21300.
- PIRATE The XZ2AH heard a few months ago...weak signal and peculiar beam heading... has been labeled a phoney by the holder of the call. Also reports no legit Burma operation since 1964. (W51ZZ)
- IWO JIMA Don, the present operator on the island will be leaving in a month from IWO JIMA. Presently Don has a daily schedule with W7IOS on 21405 around 0100GMT and also with WA8A2B Mon, Wed, Fri at 1415GMT at 14300. QSL to USCG, AFO San Francisco 96415.

RIO MUNI EAØAH, Jose, reported almost daily at 21275 at 2045GMT. QSL to CBA.

MORE ALBANIA RUMORS PY2PE reports that ZAISB has been active and may be legit. He has been reported on 14160 and 14190SSB but was QRT briefly for a license infraction. (Working W6s???). Also W6ID reports hearing stations working a ZaIST on 14050 c.w. (SCDXC)

HAITI HH9DL, Don, on 21334 at 0230 May 18th. Has been on during other summers from Cap Hatien working both 15 and 20 meters.
