SOUTH SHETLANDS With some still looking for QSL cards from the CE9AT SSB operation of last Spring, CE9AT is regularly heard around 14063kc with scheduled operating time at 1300Z and 0200Z almost daily. QSL via CE3ZN (K6OZL)

EAST PAKISTAN W4UDF/AP showed up last week, both on 15 and 20 meters. Has been worked around 1700-1800Z around 14305kc and later at 21305kc. QSL via WA9KMD. Length of operation not known.

DX-pedition It seems rather definite that Gus Browning, W4BPD, will take off on the DXpedition bit right after January 1st of the coming year. The plans, as they appear to be shaping up, is that W4ECI will again handle the QSL chores as well as the financial end. The tentative plans do call for extensive traveling on the part of Gus.

FERNANDO de NORONHA PY0ARM and PY0APS showed up on schedule and have been active daily. PY0ARM has been consistent around 14195kc listening anywhere from 5 to 30kcs up the band. PY0APS has been reported within a few kcs of 14050kc. They are scheduled to operate to September 19th.

BALEARIC EA6AR should be on right now with operations scheduled to go until the 22nd. Frequencies as announced were 14200, 21245 and 28545 SSB and 7005, 14005, 21005, and 28005kc for c.w. operations. QSL via DL7FT. EA6BH has also been reported at 14011 around 0300Z with drifting signal. (K4ZCP)

LORD HOWE ISLAND VK2BKM reports that he will operate from Lord Howe Island in the near future and hopefully during the CQWW contest, c.w. portion, in November. Operations should start around November 19th. (K6OZL)

LJ0AH If you worked this one during the WAE Contest, it was a special called used in an operation from the Valdaj Mountains in eastern Siberia during the contest.

MONACO 3A2MJC coming into the West Coast at 0100Z, 14202kc on the 11th of this month. Also active is 3A2CN who is reported as active weekends from 1700 to 1900Z around 21300kc. Also, passes information onto his QSL manager, DL7FT, Sundays around 0800Z at 14230kc. Some SSB around 7060kc from 2200-2400Z.

BOTSWANA Calls from A2A to A2Z have been assigned to Botswana by the ITU. One you will most likely come across is A2CAQ, formerly ZS9Q who regularly is found at 14200kc around 1300Z... working pileups. QSL to Box 45, Francistown. (KH6GLU)

BIG GUN Jim Neiger, ZD8Z (W6BHY) plans to operate from 8P6-land during the coming CQ Contest with the objective of attaining a record single-operator total.

MACAO VS6DR, still making a plans for a return to Macao and additional operations there later this year. Phil can be found most mornings around 14205kc from 1400Z onward. Presently getting QSLs via HARTS but may come up with stateside QSL manager.

SAN ANDRES WA6AHF/HK0 will open up this week. Will concentrate on Europe plus the West Coast. QSL via home QTH. XYL Ferne does the work while Rubin does the talking.... each to his specialty.

FRESNO INTERNATIONAL DX Convention Bob Thompson, K6SSJ, is looking for mailing lists of West Coast DX Clubs in preparation for the big January get-together. Club secretaries are asked to mail them to him at 14715 East View Drive, Los Gatos, Calif. 95030. Already the meeting of the North and the South is shaping up to be the biggest one yet.

LESOTHO U11i, 7P8AR, coming through mornings LP around 1500-1600Z around the edge of twenty phone....sometimes outside the band, sometimes in around 14212kc. QSL via W4BRE. (W6HVN)

CYPRUS ZC4GM, Gordon, from 1500Z around 14220kc. Usually LP but do not fail to check SP because sometimes the path changes quickly.

SWAZILAND ZD5R, Archie, into the Western Reaches from 0600Z around 14202kc. QSL via VE4OX. (W6HVN)


