PACIFIC WAWS and W6BPO to open up from Norfolk about February 12th for a ten day day operation around the clock. Will be joined by a VK2-operator for what appears to be an all band operation. K6KA plans for VK9-Norfolk indefinite at this time due to above operations. Frequencies in 1.69

TAHITI K6KA will operate February 15-21st...mostly local evening times there.

Possible 7-21mc operation. Will operate FQ8AA
FIJI K6KA March 15-16 during ARRL CW DX-Test. 14 mc for sure...other frequen-

cies if available. Will sign VR2AP

K6KAs frequencies: c.w. 3504, 3544, 7004, 7044, 14004, 14044 21004, 21044, 28004, 28044. Phone 3804, 3844, 3794, 7204, 7244, 7194, 14204, 14244, 14194, 21254, 21344, 21244, 28504 and 28494. May shift around but these are the frequencies to watch.

WALLIS KH6GLU and VE6AJT due to open up February 2nd for 6 days. QSLs to RH6GLU.

WESTERN SAMOA KH6GLU will operate from 5W1-1and February 8 to 13th.

MALPELO Operation headed by HK3RQ reports they have a boat lined up and are going ahead with plans for a 50-hour operation towards the end of February. Two stations will be manned around the clock and there will be 3 operators on the trip.

 amateur radio in XZ-land for the past five years.

 Also in the good news line is ACHAE-Tibet frequently found at 14003kc in
 the evenings here. Beam heading 45°. While you are listening in that direction you might listen for 8X8AA, on Cray Island. When this call came on
 the scene last June the reported QSL manager returned cards with a note that
 it was a phoney. Also, the 8X8-prefix supposedly not assigned by ITU.
- WEST P.KISTAN AP5HQ, Fida, coming in mornings and evenings...sometimes LP, sometimes SP. Mornings look around 14204kc from 1300, evenings around 14220kc or one or two higher around 0300Z. Sometimes UA9KAI has acted as MC and some give AP5HQ name as Fidel...anyhow, he's there and you should work him to keep him satisfied.
- SAO TOME Looking for Ws on Sundays around 2200Z...14200-14225kc.
- DXCC CRITERIA What constitutes a country...reprinted in the February QST. Check page 88. Be in ormed....well, give it a try anyhow.
- CHAINAIS. The boys have shut down the operation during the last week...after making a lot of contacts. No operator there from the expedition but ZLITU reported as they were closing down on January 22nd that a new operator will be going out there for a six month stay.
- QSL via VE2DCY...Gilbert reported that he is not too active these days.
