<u>COCOS IS. TI8NAM/TI9</u> opened up around opened up sudden ly on July 6th, initially operating at 14170 kc and then shifting up into the American phone band. The transceive operation was difficult due to QRM and on July 7th went to a list operation. Indications were that the operation would continue for about a week but the station apparently went QRT after the July 7th operation. The operator was Noggy who works on a purse seiner and was not too versed in DXoperation or pile-ups but who valiantly stuck in for several hours each evening of the operation.

There are at least two other groups looking for a Cocos operation within a month to six weeks. Both of these plan a full-blown operation for at least a week and multi-band operation. Those who missed Noggy and his operation should be prepared for those coming up in the near future.

PELICAN ARCHIPELAGO The VK2BFI DXpedition headed for Timor also has plans for other possible operations including Indonesia and possibly Brunei. However the new possibility is the Pelican operation for which the call will be 2PlAA...this said to be from a block of prefixes assigned to Great Britain. After the CR8-Timor and the YB4-Indonesia operations, it is hoped to operate for a week from 2Pl-Pelican. Pelican Archipelago apparently is off Timor, and once under the jurisdiction of Great Britain.
While contributions have been coming in, w5RBO reports that there are still not the minimum funds on hand and is soliciting assistance. Full information as well as the contribution angle goes through Timor DXpedition Fund, R.E.Stone, Bx 416, Anna, Texas 75003. DXday is still set for August 3rd.

- GUS Gus apparently returned to Des Roches last week, a bit of attention for his generator being part of the reason. One report received indicates that Gus may be having troubles again with his transportation arrangements. Latest information available indicates Wizard Reef this week and then on to Farguhar.
- MARTINIQUE Activity reported during the past week with more expected. FM7WO was reported at 14020kc at 1030Z on July 8th while FM7WQ was reported at 14050kc at 1040Z on the same date. Some question on the latter as Pierre is supposed to be on vacation and the home station not in especially good operating condition at this time though he has been maintaining some schedules. W3LTU is reported as preparing to operate from FM7-land July 23-August 1, both c.w. and SSB...c.w. 5kc inside band endge, SSB 5kc outside U.S.phone band. FM7EB is scheduled to open July 14th for three days. W3LTU will use a HT32 with a 3-element beam...plans to work all bands.

GABON TR8BG reported to be at 14105kc around 1900Z rather regularly.

SPECIAL PREFIXES A PD3-call has been authorized to commemorate the 50th anniverdary of wireless transmission from the Industrial Fair in Utrecht in 1919. Possibly may be used only on UH F/VHF though HF use in September a possibility. For one year commencing July 22nd Poland amateurs may use the prefix 32 rather than the customary SP-prefix....to commemorate the 25th anniversary of Polish Independence. In addition to the usual LU-prefix, Argentina has also been assigned L2A-L2Z series by the ITU.

TIMOR CR8AI, Luiz, back on the air after a sick spell and seven days abed. Luiz still needs Vermont, Delaware, Alabama and Mississippi for WAS and is also working for the California Counties Award. His schedule at this time is Wednesday 0900-1000Z at 14170kc...1230 to 15-1600Z for DX...(that's those elusive W/Ks). Saturdays 0900 to 1130Z and 1300 to 16-1700Z for DX. Other days Luiz schedule is irregular due to work demands. Being a DX station is not all gravy...he still needs Zones 23 and 34 and has worked 115 countries but has only 75 confirmed.

DXPEDITION FINANCING: With a number of DXpeditions either jelled or in the planning stages, study is being given by some to the problem of raising sufficient money to cover the major expenses and possibly the minor ones as well. With responses to fund appeals varying depending on the previous operations of the expeditioneer as well as the goal of the trip, the question of schedules for contributors or coded numerical designators for listening/transmitting frequencies.arises. With ability to raise expense money depending on the ability to deliver a new or rare country to the large contributor, there does seem to be a trend towards this type of thinking and financing.

This system would not be allowed in some countries which do not allow amateurs to receive any help whatsoever. In those countries where such might be allowed, the varying response to fund efforts and the large expense for transport, charter and gear undoubtedly will see the polishing up of some of the old techniques for fund drives plus possibly some new ones.

Whatever you thinking might be, it probably would be advantageous to give some thought to the matter....

- FRENCH FRIGATE SHOALS KHOABH at the loran station from this point....about halfway between Honolulu and Midway. QSL to USCG Loran Station, Bx 48 FPO San Fran 96610
- LG5LG From Morokulia on the border of Norway and Sweden. Previously SK9WL has been used as the call there. Was on July 6th...14200kc at 2300Z...also on when the TI9 was on...some called TI9, some LG5....for the same reason they have horse races. Was also at 14030kc at 0100Z on July 5th. QSL to LA4YF.
- SCARP REEF OH2BH/Ø/SR on 14234kd at 0300Z on July 8th. One report says its part of the OH2AM/OHØ effort. Also reported at other times.

ALBANIA Two reports....two different amateurs in two different countries reported to have secured ZA-licenses and will try to get into the country sometime this Fall. Both of these are in Europe.....something may break ne of these days, but then again, something may not break one of these days as far as Albania is concerned. Be informed but not overly-optimistic.

HI8XHG has a HyGain DB24A for 40/20m operation...says he's about 500 cards behind in his QSLing....prediction is with the new beam he may soon be 5000 cards in the hole. Look for him around 7015kc from 0400Z. 0X5BM is putting up forty and 80m dipoles to help with the 5B-gymkhana.
