QATAR Set for the coming week. MP4BHH advance party and getting equipment set up over this last week-end. Besides MP4BHH, MP4BHV, OD5BZ and MP4BHK will be on the effort. Frequencies will be:

SSB.	14185-14190kc 21290+	listening	14280-14290kc 21350+
C.W.	14020kc 21040	listening	14030+ 21050+

Will listen for QRP stations every thirty minutes after every hour, will listen for YLs 10 minutes before the hour. VE/Ws QSL to K4MQG...all others to MP4BHH. IRCs with sase...call, date and time in lower left corner of envelope.

ALBANIA Frank, DL7FT, setting March 30th as cut-off date for planning and will depart May 11th for Albania. Problem of getting gear through YU-land apparently solved. Additional frequency of 14185kc added to twenty meter operation and will also be on fifteen with two frequencies for transmitting...21235kc and 21245kc listening up the band. Gear being shipped from the states to help in the effort. Still a most expensive undertaking and assistance welcomed. No c.w. operation planned.

SELVagens Reported that Portuguese DX Group making inquiry to ARRL on possible country status for this group. The islands are south of the Madeiras and look to be just under 200 miles....South of the Madeiras.

ZANZIBAR Effort by 5H3KJ and 5H3LV set for operation from Latham Island February 28-March 1st. 24 hour operation with possibility of 48 hours. C.W. will be 10-40kc from the bottom edge of the bands....10 thru 40. SSB frequencies given are 14192kc, 21295kc, 28595kc. Possibly additional information will be available on other frequencies.

This island, south of Zanzibar, has an elevation of about 6 feet above high water. The operation will be determine what possibility there is for credit for VQ1-Zanzibar for DXCC.

COCOS TI9CF operation delayed by boat trouble....first a 48 hour delay announced, putting the operation to last Wednesday, then a second 48 hour delay was necessary and they finally opened up on Friday. Indications were that Saturday would be the end of the operation....

5BDXCC K6KA, Bill Conklin apparently the first plaque winner west of the Appalachians coming up with No. 14. WLAX, No. 7 in the 5BDXCC, came up with No. 1 in the 5BWAS.

MANIHIKI/NIUE/TOKELAU ZK2AJ, John, will be traveling on business to these areas in the coming months. Possible that his stay on each island group will be short and operating time limited but will try to operate as much as possible from each spot.

ZK1MN, Tuatai, on Manihiki and newly licensed is expecting equipment for expanded operation and may be given permission to operate other than under the restrictions for the newly licensed operators...in other words, possibly 20m SSB.

GUINEA 5U7AI reported as going to 7GL-land and possibly Dahomey TY-land. Reported may operate 7GLAI, name is Rupert. Might watch for this one at 14325kc from 1900Z....possible also at 21300kc at 100Z.

GUS W4BPD apparently feels that he has sufficient backing and is making plans for a mid-March departure. Initially may work over the FR7-spots.

THAILAND HS1LCH, Lyle, under a big pile-up at 14204kc at 0030Z on February 14th... coming through LP. Says that he will be on regularly but will split the frequencies, transmitting at 14195kc. QSL to former call, HS1LG.

VATICAN HV3SJ being operated by WA6ZWL, Charles, at 14215kc at 1500Z on Feb 11th. Will be at the station until the end of April and will operate around this frequency or above 14270kc for the General Class. East QSL to WB2ETI/West to W6KNH.

CYPRUS ZC4AK at 28515kc, 1320Z on February 10th. ZC4MT at 14196kc at 1500Z on February 11th. ZC4UA at 21327kc at 1620Z on February 11th.

MONTSERRAT W1IXL expects to be active from VP2M-Montserrat for about two weeks commencing February 15th and running through March 1st. Will work 10 thru 75m on a schedule. Weekdays: 7237kc/1100Z; 14265kc/1230Z; 14345kc/0200Z; 3835kc/0300Z. On week-ends will add to the above schedule: 28580kc/1500Z and 21430kc/1700Z. The call sign will be VP2MY.

SHORTLY NOTED Some new ones, some old ones in the Funny Farm. OJØMR showed up on 15m during the ARRL Contest....and our old pal Slim from Cray Island signing 8X8AA showed up February 5th on 40m. Said to QSL via G4TQ. Some good ones are the cards for the recent XF4-effort, being accepted by the ARRL DXCC Desk effective February 5th and the cards for TI8PE/TI9 are coming through. The OJØMR cards are supposed to be out around March 1st. 5VZDB is ex-TU2AP and W3RLI often running a list around 0130Z, 14220kc for the FB8s. There is supposed to be a W5 marooned in the American Embassy in Jordan while the recent SVØJ1 is said to have only worked 21 stations. The 5-land plans for Farnham Clifton seem to have dead-ended but others are thinking. SULMA was active again around 1500Z on Feb 14th. CO2DR QSLs have been received from CBI....last month one was received...one month by airmail from Havana. Long path no doubt. New DXCC list will be printed shortly. 7XØLOU is Louis Schezzi, ex-G3PWO, ZB1LS etc. Torres, 2nd op at CR8AJ says he will be signing CR8AJ shortly. AP5CP on mc is on schedule shown above.

BOTSWANA The Central African DX Group will make an effort from A2-land this coming Easter signing A2DX or A2CDX. Will attempt an all-band operation including 160m. QSLs will be handled by 9J2ED, Ed Thompson. This operation will be around March 29th.  
Ed will arrange for 9J2 skeds...or A2DX skeds. Send IRCs...2 for surface..6 for airmail.

MARIAN ISLAND ZS2MI showing up regularly around 14195kc. Usually from about 0200Z. Was at this frequency on February 9th and 13th....listening all the way up to 14260kc at times. Name is Des and QSLs go to ZS6LW. Good signal with the new SSB rig.

FAROES OV9LV at 14203kc at 1515Z on February 9th. Also on about the same time on February 15th. QSL to W3HNK.

SOMALILAND FL8MB, Marcel, still consistent around 14250kc from 1500Z a couple of times a week with 7Z3AB as m.c. On March 3rd at 1430Z 7Z3AB will take a list for FL8MB at 14280kc and will have FL8MB at 14280kc on March 6th at 1445Z to run through the list. On occasion activity above 14275kc to look for the General Class licensees has proven to have scant returns.

RUSSIANS RALAAT, who was at 28579kc at 1500Z on February 9th, says that his regular call is UALAAT. This may give some clue to the answer to the enigma of these calls.
