- THE BIG WEEK Many still showing the signs from the effects from the Big Week with TI9/MP4Q/KS4/OJØ/5H3/A....some with hardly enough time to recuperate in time for the ARRL DX Test. Many suffering...but still looking for more.
- MORE FCC An extensive catch-all FCC Notice of Rule Making was issued under Docket No. 18803 and some of the high points in the proposal are:
 - 97.67 Redefinition of power limits. In part it says: "Transmitter power is the d.c. power input to the final r.f. amplifier. If the final amplifier is of the r.f. grounded-grid or r.f. ground-base type, the transmitter power shall also include the d.c. power input to the stage which immediately precedes the final r.f. amplifier.
 - 97.87 Covers what call-sign to use when operation anothers station. Also goes into several other points.
 - 97.89 Apparently deletes authorization to engage in experimental one-way communication and the like may outlaw OSCARS, beacon stations, radio control, etc.

The ARRL trying to get this information into the April QST. These are the main points...study may find other matters.

St. VINCENT VP2SAU on until April. Was at 21300kc at 1900Z on February 26th.

CHINA BY1PK previously reported is said to be a club station in Peking. Being found from 0000Z onward for an hour or so....14020/14050kc. QSL route should be tried via Radio Peking.

ZANZIBAR. ARRL has indicated that this will be accepted for Zanzibar. The Minister of Telecommunications and Tourism says that Latham Island helongs to Zanzibar.

5H3KJ/A and 5H3LV/A operated from Latham Island for 16 hours February 28-March 1 as promised. During this period worked > 92 countries and about 1400 QSOS. They were away from Dar es Salaam for 28 hours, taking 7 hours for the roundtrip and 5 hours to set up the operation.

On 20m the operation was barefoot with an SB100 to a TA33 Jr. On 10 and 15 they used the HW100, SB200 and 14AVQ. They had to come ashore in a small dinghy and the swells gave some trouble with the SB100 slightly damaged in the landing. Operations commenced at about 1400Z on February 28th.

At the end of the effort they were somewhat dismayed and disenchanted because of the rudeness, uncomplimentary remarks on the operation and the QRM coused by operators who would not follow directions or even allow the completion of a QSO. Their feelings were that they would be reluctant to try another DXpedition under these conditions.

Costs were considerably more than anticipated...a last minute change of boats necessitated getting one at \$7.00 per hour. Any contributions through the QSL managers...VE3ODX for 5H3LV and W7VRO for 5H3KJ...will be greatly appreciated. Bill, 5H3KJ, leaving for home this week and his home call is LA6GF. Garth also departing from his 5H3LV QTH and headed for 9J2-Zambia later this month. In spite of the problems, a good effort and a very good QSO rate dispite the problems which irritated them. Listening to them stick in there hour after hour through the QRM certainly did evoke admiration for their doggedness.

PACIFIC ISLANDS VK9NS on Norfolk received his license in the morning of February 25. Was back in the States at 1830 local time on February 28th. Son of a gun. The travels of ZKIAJ on his two-week inspection trip will take him to Manihiki, Penrhyn, Palmerston, Aitutaki, Rakahanga and Pukapuka. Each stop will be only for a day or so and there will be limited operating time. 10/15/20meters should be worked, possibly on a regular sked/list.

John, ZKIAJ, is taking two HW32s with him on the trip. One will be delivered to ZKIMN on Manihiki and John will help him get it operating. The other HW32 will go to Niue--ZK2AF..(not the M.D. now in Oconto Falls, Wis)..or to 5WIAR to hold for future operations of ZM7AF on the Tokelaus. Previous efforts of ZM7AF were somewhat frustrating due to his low power and poor receiver sensitivity. The two HW32s were made available through the courtesy of K3RLY and WA5REU. Reported that ZMIBN/A-Snares will count only for New Zealand. KC6EJ, Jack (ex-KW6EJ), in Ponape, Eastern Carolines often found low end of twenty from O2OOZ...looking for WA6AHF, the Big QSL Manager. In the Solomons, VR4BC is active daily around 14130kc from O9OOZ. VR4EK and VR4EL should be active again...before the end of March. VR4EZ down in New ZMealand. Two new VR4s expected to be on the air soon and expect to be on 40/80. ZKIAA in Rarotonga has a beacon on 50.1mc and watches for c.w. calls from 0600 to 1200Z. Fast QSL for VHF QSOS.

ZKLAJ also in the Cooks has a 2-el Quad up for 10/15/20 up about this time.... often found on twenty meters. QSLs go to KH6GLU...a stamp collector.

SILENT KEY Tony Willis, ex-ZL2AJW/VS6FS/G3TKY, and his XYL were killed in an auto accident near Kampala, Uganda, last February 22nd. His most recent call was 9J2NW and he was about to resume activity from 5X5-land after a long effort to obtain authorization. Tony's other calls were ZL3GI, ZD1NWW, ZD2NWW, VS9ANW and ST2AZ. He had just been married a year and will be missed by his many friends in the Pacific Area including Hongkong, New Zealand and the Pacific Islands. A tragic loss of a fine DXer.

This same call was used by Donald Hoff back a few years...he went QRT from Rhodes in April 1967. For those with ancient Call Books, the address is Issac Murphey, U.S. Embassy-VOAR, APO N.Y. 09223
- DAHOMEY..? TY6ATE on again ... 21291kc at 2000Z on February 19th. Gave name as 'Fred'. When queried he QSYed to UMbRAGE.....shocking language !!! Strong Limey accent. Anyone with more information on this one??.
- ALBANIA Frank, DL7FT, still completing the planning. For those with doubts it might be pointed out that Franks record in past DX efforts is exceptional. He strongly feels that he can pull this one off but many of the arrangements are in the shadowy areas and cannot be talked about. Even his enroute trip must be circuitous. The proof must come in May if all goes well. Still an expensive project....DL7FT must look for support for the expenses. The deadline for the financial planning is the end of March.
