AVES Additional information on the coming YVØ-Aves Island effort has been received from YV1LA. Basically it is intended to be a phone effort though there will be some c.w. operation on 40/20/15.

The effort is scheduled to open operations on Thursday, April 30th and to operate through May 3rd. There will be two transmitters on the air simultaneously working on different bands, the operators using either their own call or the group call. Identification of the station operating will be at least every 15 minutes and those working YVØ-Aves are requested to listen rather than to ask the station for identification. JORDAN Wayne Green heard from JY-land Thursday morning last but not working a large number of stateside stations though some did get through. Also reported as being on Friday but the great expectations unfulfilled as yet. Some concern that the anti-American riots in Amman might affect the operation. Expects to operate to this coming Thursday if all goes well. King Husseins gear includes a Drake T4XB, R4B with the Drake L4 linear....using a 14AVQ Hy-Gain antenna. Has been reported as firing up on 10 meters on a Sunday a few weeks back. Wayne was on Saturday morning from 1400 to around 1630Z, first appearing around 14235kc, later shifting to around 14255kc when QRM built up, then going back to 14235kc. Was signing JY1 and said to QSL to Box 1055, Amman, Jordan. In this instance Wayne was able to work a large number of W/Ks.

CROZET FB8WW, Robert, reported active on Saturdays. Has shown up 14075-14080kc on recent Saturdays from 1500Z, coming through LP. QSL via F5QE.

SIKKIM AC3PT, Namu, showing up a couple of times a week, usually Mon/Wed/Fri. Was at 14250kc last Friday from 1430Z, working some stateside stations through the pileup but finally working Europeans. Often disappears under a cloud of JAs. Usually coming through SP. Was also on April 10, 13th which would confirm the Mon/Wed/Fri schedule to some degree, Namu showing up two Fridays in a row. Some effort being made to have him go to working by prefixes/districts in an effort to cut down the QRM.

GUS Still in the U.S. and expecting that his plans would be firmed up by this past week-end. Plans to go direct to Nairobi and then either on to the Indian Ocean areas of possible side trips to XT2, TZ or whatever might be available though his plans in this area are reported to be somewhat indefinite at this time.

SUDAN ST2SA coming through on occasion. Was at 21045kc at 2015Z on April 13th. Also at 14021/1510Z on April 10th. Sid will have a schedule at 0400Z on April 28-30th around 14020kc. QRM will drive Sid away so anyone watching for him should wait until he runs his schedule. The receiver at the ST2SA QTH is not the best and spreading out will help him pick out a signal.

TRANSIENTS 9N1RA will be leaving Nepal along about the end of May, returning to California and Minnesota for the summer months and back to India in the Fall. ZM3PO/C expects to leave Chatham along about May 10th. C2LJW, Jack, expects to be leaving Fauru in the near future.

ALBANIA A persistent station showing up is ZA1BY who often shows up at the low end of twenty around 0300Z. Says his name is Tchang which brings up the interesting point that the call put backwards can be made out as BY1ZA etc. Some stations report hearing this one four or five times. Says to QSL to BX 44, Tirana and that he will answer direct. Operating techniques identical each time he is on and disappears under a pile-up. Pile-ups run about 50% Russian stations...with one instance of a Russian QRPer asking a U.S. station for assistance in getting through. QRPer stick together.

DL7FT and DL7VY still going ahead with plans. ARRL has indicated that in the absence of amateur licenses not being issued in Albania in the normal manner, they will consider other proof of operation. Also reported is that OH-land amateurs have applied for ZA-entry, they being able to get in with a tourist permit. DL7FT still planning for September if support develops.

EAST AFRICAN DESK 5Z4KL is reported to be expecting no trouble in obtaining a license for a FH8-Comoro operation and may go in August if things jell. Andre, being a school teacher, probably would be needing some help and an estimate of the cost of a Comoro operation has been scaled at around \$300.00 601KM has left Somaliland, leaving in late March, and is on his way to Tristan da Cunha where he will sign ZD9KWM.

FP8CY, Yvon, expects to be transferred to FH8-Comoro late this Fall but probably will not be active until 1971.

5H3LV, Garth, at the latest report will be returning to Zanzibar late this month but apparently plans no further operations due to the scant support for the Latham Island effort last February. 5H3KJ, Bill, has returned to the Norway locale, probably for good.

5Z4KL still looking for a possible ST2-Sudan effort but no developments on this so far and Andre talking with the Sudanese Ambassador to Kenya about this one. ST2SA was at 14021kc at 1510Z on April 10th. Worked into 6-land. Sid forwarding QSL cards to K6KA....and still hoping to acquire some better equipment. Still using an 807-crystal controlled along with an ancient receiver. Sids wife just had their fourth child.....
