CAMPBELL ISLAND ZM4OL showed up rather regularly last week on twenty meters. No set frequency and was as low as 14220kc and up to 14260kc. November 2nd was at 14221kc/0530Z. The following day was at 14228kc/0420Z; at 14257kc/0500Z and at 14225kc/0505Z. The station there on Campbell has been vacant several years and the weather station had to be rebuilt first before anything else could get any attention. Apparently Quantas is going to revamp the whole set up. Some reports indicate the ZL prefix--some the ZM prefix. Best not to quibble but work them first.

On one contact indicated that they would be there a year and there would be plenty of time to work everyone. ZM4JF should also show up soon from Campbell and his operating frequencies will be: 3535, 3690, 3825, 7015, 7090, 14035, 14125, 14250, 21035, 21350, 28035 and 28550kc. This one QSLs via ZM2AFZ.

AFRICAN EXPEDITION DJ1QP and DJ6QT should be active now, having arrived in Africa last week at Bamako in Mali. They hoped to be operating from there a few days after their arrival. This will be followed by XT or 5U7, then TY9/TY0 and if time allows, some 5V-Togo action. Before leaving for CT3-Madeira around the 14/15th of November, they expect to operate from ZD3-Gambia. Their stay in Madeira is expected to extend to December 6th.

Their present plans are to operate on all bands in the CW portion of the CQ DX Contest later this month. They have had no answer on their inquiries for Annonbon or Fernando Po. No especial operating plan on the bands is planned and they will look for optimum conditions. Attention will also be given to forty and eighty meter operation. DJ6QT will handle the SSB and DJ1QP the C.W.

TOKELAUS VE7HE and VE8RA plan to arrive in Pago Pago about November 15th, looking for ZM7-Tokelaus activity. Arrangements have already been made by Jerry Johnson and Vince Sullivan there in Samoa for transportation of the two VEs to the southernmost of the Tokelaus.

They will have two KWM-2s and plan to operate as much as possible each day for at least a week....possibly longer should there be anything left to work. QSLs will be handled by VE7BWG.

Primarily this is a VE-effort with the INDXA coming in to help somewhat with antennas and transportation. However, the INDXA says that this is almost a 100% VE effort. So far no solicitation for any assistance has been forthcoming.

SOUTH SHETLANDS Two stations showing up. CE9AT was at 14048kc at 0330Z on Oct 30th. A few days later CE9AG coming through at almost the same time and frequency.... 14046kc at 0500Z. Both QSL via CE3RR. CE9AGE is a Chilean station in the Antarctic and also goes via CE3RR...this one being at 14051kc at 0330Z on Nov 4th.

NAURU C21AA new operator on the island....will be there for four years....home call of this one is VK2ASZ.

COCOS KEELING AX9YR, 14250kc at 1530Z on November 7th...good signal.

NEUTRAL ZONES 7Z3AB mid-November plans now off until next February.

QSL MANAGER OF THE MONTH Dick Moen, W7VRO, has been named QSL Manager of the Month for November by Scott's QSL Service and has received the Golden Microphone trophy, being the third to receive the award. W7VRO was cited for having handled over 30,000 QSL cards as manager for a number of DX stations including CR7IK, HM9AB, HMLAB, KR6MB, KR6NG, KZ5GN, PY2BGL, YB9AAJ, ZSLXR, 5N2AAF, 5H3KJ and 5H3KJ/A. In recent weeks Dick has been in the Caribbean operating from several VP2 spots plus other nearby 8P6.
