ANDAMAN Etc VU9KV went QRT last Thursday, having pretty thoroughly worked over the need for the Andaman Islands. Venkat consistently had a strong signal and last Tuesday was well over 5x9 into the West Coast on the morning SP.

Reports indicate that Venkat operated on a number of bands, reports being received of 10/15/20m operations plus an unconfirmed one that he was found on 40m. QSLs go to W6KNH who expects the cards from the printer within the week. Venkat has indicated that he would appreciate a \$2.00 membership in the Amateur Radio League of India should anyone wish to give some support to the effort.

VUZPJ also has a license for the Andamans good until mid-May but on April 15th he indicated that he saw little good in another Andaman effort right after Venkat's successful effort.

The VU7US Laccadives operation was reported more during the closing days of its operations. The reports received indicated that it was the eastern portion of the W/K-land which worked the effort, these all showing twenty meters c.w. and the last one was on April 17th. One unverified report indicated that they had a low total of QSOs, something over a thousand being mentioned.

Venkats effort from the Andamans was another howling success and certainly matched his VU5-effort of Tast January.

TONGA VR5DK, Darlene, being reported regularly from Tonga. She should be there through mid-May, possibly going on to ZL-land from Tonga.
