

YEMEN $4 W I$ continues to come through a couple of times a week, being at 21290kc last week from 1700 Z and with the Western Reaches getting through around 18002. The full name of the operator there is Klaus Pluer and he will be in Sana for another year. QSLs go via DJ9ZB who say that it will be late in October before QSLs are being received by those who worked Klaus. Previously a large number of stations

- were able to get through on September 23rd.

BHUTAN JA-stations continue to report Yo ten coming through from lC5TY with an a.m. signal. His favorite frequencies are : ported to be $14158,14185,14195 \mathrm{kc}$ in the $1400-1500 Z$ time slot. He is getting s ective to some degree and last week was asking for $\Lambda$ fricons only.
Those working ACSTY and wondering about the validity of QSLs in Bhutan need not worry. His brother-in-law is the Director of Posts and Telegraph there in Bhatan. Ionten is presently looking for a couple of 5 to 10 kw transmitters for broadcast use on medium-wave bands and a half to a full kw for his own use on SSB. Bhutan recently established relations with a number of countries, including Switzerland and the U.S., and he is working on developing a communication system with the overseas ministers for Bhutan.
Present gear includes a BC-610E, Mark IV, and a BC-342....the latter needing a few parts right now.
