SWAN ISLAND KV4AM will activate Swan Island, signing KS4CJ, during the period December 8th to 21st. The planned frequencies for the operation will be 3500-3530kc; 3800-3820kc; 7000-7030kc; 7200-7230kc; 14020-14040kc; 14220=14230kc and 14270kc; 21020-21-3-kc; 21320-21330kc; 28020-28030kc; 28520-28530kc.

In this operation KV4AM says that he will concentrate on ten meters and eighty meters as much as possible and considering the conditions existing on the bands. 15/20/40 will also get a good work-out. QSLs will go to H.R. Mc Birney, P.O. Box 717, Christiansted, St. Croix, U.S. Virgin Islands 00820.

The status of Swan Island in the future is somewhat unclear at this time with the United States saying the island will be turned over to Honduras. This transfer is still pending as the treaty which was announced last week still has to be approved by the U.S. Senate. The islands are but 100 miles off the coast of Honduras and thus would not exactly qualify for DXCC under the present criteria.

All is not exactly harmonious in this transfer with Sumner Smith up in Massachusetts saying the islands belong to him and the U.S. has no right to be so free with his property. Seeing that the U.S. paid him rent for the islands in the past, Sumner might have a point.

Anyhow, while this high level wrangle continues, it might be opportune to consider more important things and work KS4CJ this week. Thats the real thing!!!

BHUTAN AC5TY being heard on SSB, WØDAD/KH6 reports that Thuji was at 14205kc and 14215kc just after 1200Z on November 25th. WB6RIU/HL9 also reports hearing him on 14mtr SSB on November 21st around 1245Z.

In both instances 4S7PB was helping with a list and VKs were getting through though the signal was rather weak in Korea. 3B8CZ was also in there with an assist.

On c.w., AC5TY will attempt to operate 1600-1700Z in the 14024-14030kc area....or thereabouts....trying to get into the Western Reaches. At the present time there is an application by Bhutan to the ITU for the assignment of a prefix. AC5TY is reported to be hearing many stations with the Hallicrafter rig but has difficulty in raising them due to his present power and antenna.

There is a report that possibly other operators will operate from Bhutan and more of that a bit further on.

While this list is impressive, preliminary work has been done by Signal ONE on these and permission is pretty well in hand for all except FO8C-Clipperton. In other words, these plans are almost jelled.

The trips are not intended to be long-drawn affairs but a couple of days operation at the minimum will be had at each spot. There has been talk of K2IXP/6 heading for Bhutan sometime in February. Larry will be at Fresno and it is possible that late information will be developing about that time.

Whatever does develop.....it might be a good year if Signal ONE plans even hit the 50% mark. 100% would be, as they say in SouCalif, "Stupendous".
