

KAMARAN Recent reports indicate that the planned effort by Aldo, EIBITJ, has been put off for about six months. Still planned but delayed a bit.

SOUTH SHETIIANDS LUIZC showed from Deception Island last week-end but apparently no large number found him at 14195 kc . Most reports indicate that they worked the station on the 10th from 0400 Z onwards. QSLs go to K4VZU.

BOUVET This one still alive and some reports that it may surnface soon. A ZS1 is being mentioned as the one who will be the operator there and the call sign vill have a prefix of $3 Y \varnothing$. If construction on the weather station by the South African government is to get started this year, the next few m aths will be the period when weather conditions are more favorable.

SPRATLY WASVTU apparently got close to the islands but conditions wero not favorable for landing. On the possible use of the 1S1A call-sign, apparently the ITU has asked the ARRL to try to discourage the use of this prefix, it never havinf officially been issued and they would rather not have it appropriated. It has been indicated that in such instances where there are no proper call signs that just the call sign of the operator with the geographical location as a suffix. In this instance it might have ended up as WA5VIU/Spratly.

That ca $\varnothing$-prefix used at Nauru is said to be only used on holidays....such as January lst. It may surface again one of these days....the problem being to know when it is a holiday there. Some of the British Colonies and former British Colonies nevor did get around to making the 4th of July a national holiuay.
JD6-will be the prefix for Okinawa to replace the KR8 onc issued by the vacating authorities there. JH6ALF has been heard on 21 mtr C .W.
KJ6BZ on most days at 21285/2200Z looking for the Middle West and East Coast. He
will be leaving the end of January for a vacation and will return to Johnston on March 2nd.
VR5FX still very active from Tonga.....usually found on twenty cow in the 14235kc to 14250 kc . A week ago was at $14046 / 0900 \mathrm{Z}$. Often on earlier.

WALLIS/NEV CALEDONIA VE8RA, Karl, has his planned Pacific operation firmed and has forwarded the details. His plans call for Wallis--FW8 from March 14 th to March 22 nd and New Caledonia-FK8 from March 22-27th.....or extended to April 3rd if tho activity warrants.
Prior to heading out to the Pacific, he rill head down to Brazil for a visit with PYaPE, departing Brazil around March Oth. Karl will operate on all bands from Wallis/New Caledonia, using a Hy-Gain 18 AVT if it arrives in time. He will try to use a Quad on the higher frequencies if certain materials are available locally. At both places he will use split frequency including listening in the General Class portions of the bands. Those using transceivers are asked to indicate this by adding "transceive" to their calling format. Short calls preferred. QSLs will again be handled by VEPBWG. More details as the awaited dates near.

HIIMI HH9DI, the one and only true-blue HH9 in residence, active again as promised. Was at 14220 kc at 2250 z a week or so ago.
