

BONINS-OGASAWARA JDLACH will be on the Ogasawara Islands for a month commencing February 7th, operating on all bands. Initially, JA3GZN will be the operator and later JH1OTD will be in the island group to sign JDLADK from mid-March to the first part of May. Then another handful of JAs will drop in for a couple of weeks vacation to put JD1ABX, JD1ABS and JD1AAL. This group will include JA1KSO, JA1OJE, JA1MIN and JA1OAF.

The operating frequencies of JD1ACH will be:

SSB: 28595/21295/14195/7085/3560kc CW: 28045/21045/14045/7005/3505kc

It is anticipated that the main action will be on twenty meters but the other bands will be used when conditions permit. The station expects to be active in both the SSB and CW portions of the ARRL DX Test. The gear includes a FT400, an FT200, a tri-band Yagi and a dipole for 40/80m.

On the 40/80mtr bands, the action should be a bit later in the month and the schedule calls for 7005kc from 1000-1100Z. 3505kc from 1100-1200Z with this effort being most c.w. at these times. Twenty is expected to be pushed from 0800-0900Z at 14195kc.

QSLs will go to JA3GZN, Masanobu Katsus i, 1-6-3 Nanamatsu Amagasaki, Hyogo 660, Japan. JA3GZN was expecting to arrive on the island this Monday and will be active as soon as he can get things organized.

REVILLAGIGEDO XEIJ will again head up an effort from XF4 in mid-March, there will be three operators signing 6D4-prefixes from March 16th to 23rd. Those making the trip will be XEIFFC who will sign 6D4FFC, XE3EB who will sign 6D4EB and XE1J who will sign 6D4J. There will be two Drake TR4s with Linear and remote VFO and a complete YAESU line, also with linear. There will be a TA-33 beam and inverted Vee for antennas.

A THE ALL AND A THE ADDRESS OF ADDRESS OF

MINERVA REEF A recent dispatch by the Reuters correspondent at Suva in the Fijis concerns Minerva Reef and....Son of a Gun....might even lead to some activity in the area if all is as reported. The report goes like this:

An international group claims to have established an 'away-from-it-all" republican state on the desolate sea-washed Minerva Reefs in the Pacific about 450 miles south of Fiji.

Fiji has been asked to recognize the state, established by the self-styled Ocean Life Research Foundation of New York and London.

Two dredges are due to arrive at the reef in three weeks to begin reclaiming up to 400 acres of land on Minerva.

Mark Oliver, a U.S. Citizen who said he is one of the three directors of the foundation, said in Suva Wednesday their intention was initially to build a port and later a 'sea city' as a haven for people who wanted to escape from crippling taxes, riots, crime and drug addicts.

"We decided on Minerva after a worldwide search because research showed conclusively that the reefs do not belong to anyone", he said.

"By International Law one can claim by annexation only land above the sea that can be built upon.

"We have met this requirement by constructing two small islands of coral and sand on the reefs."

Oliver said the Ocean Life Research Foundation, established 18 months ago and backed by scholars throughout the world, was serious about a sea city republic at Minerva.

International engineering companies had been consulted and expenditures on the project, so far, totaled \$180,000.00, he added.

Don Miller operated from Minerva in the mid-60s, this being the last operation there and possibly the only one. The prefix 1M4 was used, this being an unofficial and latest work is that the ITU has asked that any prefix using the number '1' not be used seeing that they never authorized it. The current DXCC country list still carries this while a few others such a Geyser. Blenheim and Maria Theresa have been put in the Don Miller Memorial Corner at the end of the listings.

While reports crop up from time to time on Maria Theresa and its depth below the low-water mark.....some saying that it is several thousand feet below... Minerva shows up from time to time, usually when some fishing boat piles up on the reefs and the crew has to be rescues. Some groups including amateurs who presently are stationed on Mid-Pacific Islands, have been studying the charts in the Pacific looking for areas which may possibly qualify for new country status. Sooner or later there will be action from some of these.....but probably not from Maria Theresa....unless we can locate an unusually tall amateur.

W2CTN A West Coast station reports working W2CTN on twenty meters on January 21st after Jack had been off the air for close to a year. This was taken as a sign that his health has improved to the point where he was able to feel like getting on the air again.

ARRL BOARD MEETING Some have indicated interest in the last ARRL Board of Directors '... Meeting held on January 20/21st so here is the Official Bulletin on it. The March issue of QST will carry the full minutes of the meeting.

The Board of Directors of the American Radio Relay League at its Annual Meeting in Hartford, Conn, January 20/21 revised ARRL Administrative Structure to meet more effectively the challenges Amateur Radio will face in the coming decade. After-expressing the view that dual responsibilities of ARRL and IARU Presidencies have grown beyond the capabilities of one man, Robert W. Denniston, WØDX, declined to be a candidate for re-election as ARRL President. The Board chose Harry J Dannals, W2TUK, as the new ARRL President, re-elected Charles G. Compton, WØBUO, as 1st Vice-president, and named Denniston and Roemer O Best, W5QKF, as additional Vice-presidents. President-elect Dannals proposed, and the Board unanimously voted, to seek approval from IARU Societies of Robert W Denniston to serve as President of the IARU. John R Griggs, W6KW, was newly elected to the Executive Committee. To cover rising costs of operation and to meet future needs, effective July 1, 1972 annual dues were raised to \$7.50 in the U.S., \$8.50 in Canada and will be \$9.00 elsewhere. The setting of goals and objectives in long range planning was assigned to a special Ad Hoc committee, with recommendations to be submitted at the July meeting. Another special group will promote and implement the growth of the new amateur satellite service. The VHF Repeater Advisory Committee is requested to recommend a structure of Regional Frequency Coordination Committees to facilitate repeater operation. The Board examined long range plans for protection of present amateur freq= uencies and a program for attempting assignment of additional bands at any future high-frequency Allocations Conference. Studies to be made by committees or others include the problems of parts procurement for constructors, establishment of VHF Beacon Stations, sponsorship of technical symposia and a Herbert Hoover Jr. Memorial Amateur Station in the West. Requests will be of FCC for rules changes to permit Technicians and higher to use 50.0 to 50.1Mhz, to relax logging requirements, to require filtered D.C. power supplies on frequencies above 144 Mhz as well as below, and to grandfather from Advanced to Extra those with 40 years amateur experience and who have reached 60 years of age. The ARRL Technical Merit Awara went to Mel Wilson W2BOC//1DET, The Board expressed its deep appreciation for dedicated service of elected and appointed MRRL volunteer officials, and its thanks to FCC and DOC for cooperat= ion in amateur regulatory matters in the past year. Proposals which failed for adoption included separate mobile and RTTY DXCC and WAS Awards, cash awards Mfor QST articles, putting QST on newsstands and rotation of Board Meetings on a fixed schedule around the continent. Minutes of the Meeting will be in March QST.
