WALLIS ISLAND VE8RA got as far as Noumea and then had trouble with his plans. Last week he operated from New Caledonia signing FK8CD but this week should open from FW8-Wallis. A message from Karl last week said he would open up on March 21st and would operate through April 4th and that all is well. Karl was consistently coming through with a strong signal last week and should be available this week from Wallis. QSL to VE6TP . . .

NAVASSA This DXpedition will sign KC4DX is plans to open the operation at 2300Z on Friday, May 12th. There will be 10 through 160 meter operations, both c.w. and SSB. The operation is aiming at a 24-hour, around the clock operation with the band being used being the **highest open to U.S.** for SSB. In this arrangement with SSB on the highest frequency band to the U.S., c.w. operations will be on the next lower band from the SSB operation. Operating frequencies will be:

Operations will be transceive on the indicated frequencies until QRM drives them to switch to call area operation or possibly listening up frequency. QSLs will go to W4GKF or to KC4DX, P.O. Box 11555, Atlanta, Ga. 30305. U.S. QSOs should send the card with sase.....outside the U.S. sae with two IRCs. Charles Cone, W4GKF, is the trustee for KC4DX.

SAM YATES Sam Yates, KA2AI, will be leaving the Tokyo area the end of the month to spend his leave on a tour of Asia....with hopes to get into some rare DX spots. He has his round-trip travel arrangements made to Calcutta, leaving Japan March 30th and he plans to visit Hong Kong, India, Nepal, Thailand and Formosa. He will be in India for almost two weeks and at that time will see if he can arrange for licenses to get into Sikkim and Bhutan. Sam has 30 days leave and will spend it in the above listed spots. The problem is that should he get the AC-permission, there would be little oppprtunity to spread the word.

Sam should be in Hongkong March 30th and in India April 2nd. He should be in Katmandu around April 4th and back in India around the 8th. Something might jell anytime but it would be good to do some listening from April 8th onwards and possibly work Sam at some of the other spots that he gets on the air to catch any late developments. This is mostly guesswork with a multitude of 'ifs'. But if you should catch Sam at one you need, who would worry 'if' it was unexpected.

CONGO REPUBLIC Another iffy one. EX-ZD8AY will be in the 9Q5/TN8 area during the entire month of April and hopes to be active.....including some 160mtr activity. The report says that he will be going to TN8....which might get a bit more attention than any 9Q5 operation.

NOTES ARRL Bulletin #364 reminds that the AMSAT-OSCAR C satellite is expected to be put in orbit this July, piggy-backing on the ITOS D meteorological satellite. This is a long-lifetime satellite designed to repeat a 100khz segment of the two-meter band on the ten meter band. You can check March QST for more details. Those UA5Ø-UB5Ø-UC5Ø stations coming out of Russia are to continue right through their call areas, there usually being five stations with suffixes 'A' through 'E' in on the action. The stations will be on for a week, rotating through the various Soviet Republics with Wednesday supposed to be the starting day for each new prefix. They may not follow a strict alphabetical progression.....as we know the alphabet.. and a couple of the rarer ones are scheduled for:

UA5Ø - 3-10 May UJ5Ø 10-17 May UG5Ø 17-24 May  
Red-Eyed Louie has been reporting many of these deep Russians but they are still hard to corner. WA5EFL, Moritz, who was a quick source for UM8FZ QSLs became a Silent Key recently.

UAØYT in Zone 23, in Tana Tavu, has a transceiver which gives him problems in the transmitting section. Still, he is often on 15mtrs on Saturdays and mainly working Europe. He hopes to construct a quad this summer. Also heard from this Zone 23 country is UAØYA and UAØYAE.
