On the FW8-Walis and EK8-New Caledonia QSLs for $\mathrm{F}^{8} \mathrm{D}_{\mathrm{AB}}$ and $\mathrm{FK} \mathrm{C}^{8} \mathrm{CD}$ efforts by $\mathrm{VF} \mathrm{B}^{8} \mathrm{RA}$ last March and April, Karl says that all QSLs should have gone out and if you have not had yours received, drop another to VE6TP in mamonton. All the cards should be out by now.
