CHINA A station signing JA1MWI/BY has been active in the last week, usually being in the 14025kc-14050kc area. The operator says he has a license to use c.w. only on twenty and fifteen meters and he will be around most days from after 0000z to maybe 0300z and indicated there would be no week-end operations. The operator said that he is prohibited from working UA-stations but that the W/Ks and JAs are okay. Gave his handle as 'yos', said he was in Kwangtung and QSLs should be sent to JA1ZZ. The consistent appearance of this station is a plus. His code speed is around 20wpm and some verification on the legitimacy will be coming from the JA-Desk before long. In the meanwhile, work them first and worry later.

St. PETER AND PAUL The planned effort by PY2WH was scratched at the last moment. Les recently changed jobs and his new employer was a bit adamant about Les sticking close to the foundry rather than luxuriating on St. Peter and Paul. Word at the week-end was that any activity was off for a couple of months at the minimum though Les would still like to make the trip if possible.

FERNANDO de NORONHA PY7ZAH/PYØ showed up on Fernando de Noronha last week and should be there though this week. Handle is Jim and he QSLs to Bx 91, Recife, Brazil. There are all-band capabilities there but no especial frequency has been mentioned. Jim was at 21302kc/1725z last week.

AVES YV5ANF has relayed the information on the up-coming Aves Island expedition by the Radio Club Venezolana and the operation should open around January 9th....give or take a few hours. The plans are for a departure from Caracas on Sunday, January 7th with the Venezuelan Navy furnishing transportation to the island. There will be twelve operators with three stations, one on c.w. and two on SSB. On their arrival on January 9th, they will get on the air as quickly as possible and will operate through January 12th. The following are their planned frequencies:

The 75 mtr phone frequency may be subject to change, possibly depending on conditions and QRM. The call to be used is club call YVØAA and QSLs will go to Bx 2285, Caracas, Venezuela. The group will have three or four generators available for the trip and power supplies should be no problem. This will be the first YVØ-Aves effort since the May 1970 effort by other YV-amateurs. The general planning for Aves is to have a dxpedition there every three years or so and thus the next one should not be until 1976 after this one is completed.

HEARD ISLAND The difficulties previously reported with the engine room problems on the USS Eltanin apparently have scuttled the hoped for Heard Island VK0AAA action scheduled for November. The trouble included some engine room flooding, generator problems and fire and the ship was last heard as being in Australia for repairs. There is a possibility that when the vessel puts to sea again that it may pass by F8-Crozet but while a license has been applied for nothing has jelled on this. It is possible that the Eltanin will be in the vicinity of Mauritius late this month.

SHORTLY NOTED Our reconnaissance report on Clipperton says that conditions have been ideal during the latter part of November with the ocean swell down to nothing, the winds 3-5 mph and it being possible to walk ashore without any difficulty. Several still looking for the key to an F8-operation but no one seems to be able to get around the French Admiralty who say they do not wish any rash efforts to land on Clipperton because they would have to rush there and rescue the unfortunates. In other words, they are watching out for the imprudent. That's their story...not ours. One recent expedition found itself reportedly stuck with a several hundred dollar hotel bill when out of the participants split for home leaving them holding the sack for the bill.

FANNING The VR3ZC group headed by W6GQU should be heard by the end of this week, the group planning a four day operation. The frequencies will be:

The group has arranged to use facilities owned by the University of Hawaii on Fanning provided a medical clinic is provided during the stay to check on the health of the residents there. There are three physicians in on the trip and ten residents on the island so this should provide ample medical coverage. The university facilities include tower, housing and other needs. Action expected to start about 0400 Dec 9th... This is an INDXA effort and QSLs should go to K3RLY.

QSLs There is a report that one of the operators at.....got pushed out of shape at some of the antics of those trying to work the station and has salted away parts of the logs containing entries for about 2000 contacts. His opinion is that amateur radio is a hobby and not a battle marked by desperation to achieve a QSO and a coveted QSL. Meanwhile, the courteous are suffering with the discourteous. Bill says that those who QSL to Mombassa should refile to him as Harry, VQ9HCS, will not be able to answer them until he returns to the United Kingdom in early summer of '73. Meanwhile, the recent contacts are being passed over the air. What is all boils down to, if you want a VQ9HCS, QSL to WA1HAA with sase or sae/IRC.

ARRL The recent ARRL Directors election brought but a single change. All the incumbents were reelected save for the vice-director spot in the southwestern division where Gary Stillwell, W6NJK, won over the incumbent vice-director, Arnold Dahlman, W6UEI, by 98 votes. Gary Stillwell, W6NJK, is a well-known southern California DXer, a former president of the southern California DX Club and the second W6 to earn a 5BDXCC plaque.

All the other contests found the present chair holders winning easily, in some instances by landslides and this must be taken as an indicator that the ARRL membership is generally satisfied with the conduct of the organization.
