AVES A scientific group will be on Aves Island for the next thirty to forty days to do work involving the sea turtle and bird population on the island. The Green Sea Turtles are considered an endangered species and the study is made by the Island Resources Foundation in connection with the Venezuelan government. While there is a reciprocal agreement with Venezuela, Aves-YVØ has been set aside as a preserve for YV-amateurs only.

VP2VAN will be one of the amateurs on the study and there are others. The group will be maintaining contact with the outside by amateur radio and most likely will be found regularly on the Caribbean Net at 1100Z/7160Kc. KV4FZ is the usual Net Control on this daily gathering.

Bill Rainey, the Senior Research Scientist, on the Aves trip is a fine operator and previously has pursued scientific studies on Aves. What call-sign may be used is not known but you might listen on the Caribbean Net for additional information. The gear does include a FT-DX 560.

The problem of reciprocal licensing being limited to serve local needs may start to develop in other areas. Depending on what side of the fence one might be, there is considerable rationalization to defend ones feeling in such matters and somewhere along the line there will have to be a decision as to whether reciprocal licensing means just that or not.

Anyhow, listen for the group. It might also be kept in mind that there are still an awful lot of amateurs who need YVØ-Aves in spite of the effort by the Venezuelan Radio Club last January when they signed YVØAA.

JUAN FERNANDEZ K5QHS, Dr. Sanford Hutson, will open from Juan Fernandez signing the call K5QHS/CEØZ next Friday, September 14th if all the plans jell as hoped. In addition to this call, CE3ABZ, Alex, may also be on the effort to sign CE3AA/CEØZ. The present plans call for departure from Little Rock on September 11th and arrival in Santiago on September 12th. Arrival on the island is expected to be early on Friday, September 14th if all goes well. If it does not, Saturday, September 15th is expected to be the sure thing.

CE3ABZ, Alex, is not listed for any c.w. and does not expect to operate in that mode. After the first two or three days, K6QHS will devote part of the time to operating c.w. and will operate on ten and fifteen meters, this being done in response to the request of many W/K amateurs. 40/80mtrs will be the program from 0300Z to around 1000/1100Z and there will be a break in working DX Stations to listen for W/Ks every hour for a short period.

Gear will include a beam antenna, two 12AVQs, two dipoles, a GT550, FT DX 200 and FT DX 400 with a total of 3 transceiv'rs. As of this last week-end the effort was 99% set and the only worry was possible complications from the present political situation in Chile.

QSLs go to Dr. Sanford Hutson, Box 218, Broken Bow, Oklahoma 74728. This is a change from older Call Books. An M.D., K5QHS will be taking medical gear with him on the trip for any possible needs. Sase or Sae/IRCs needed for QSL. Any support for the effort will also be appreciated.

SUNSPOT LOUIE..... Take Hope!! Those who Think Sunspots are getting results. Take a look at this chart....some good results have been achieved. A medium sized spot about 15000 miles in diameter appeared on August 25th. The spot has remained fairly stable since it appeared with little change in appearance. Prior to the appearance of this spot, there had been a period of 16 days without any significant sunspots. Propagation conditions have generally been poor. WWV has been forecasting unsettled conditoions during most of this period and as of last Friday there had been some improvement and WWV was advising of 'quiet' conditions with a N-6 forecast. SKYLAB is crossing the U.S. nightly from southwest to northeast and is visible nights when cloud cover does not interfere. It can be seen moving at a rapid rate and much brighter than any star. Most times your local newspaper will give the times for the passage in your area.

ARRL League officials have been spending some time in Washington to develop a better understanding with those heading the Safety and Special Radio Services Bureau. This is the bureau which includes the Amateur and Citizens Division. President Harry Dannals and Secretary John Huntoon met there in mid-August with Charles Higginbotham, the Acting Chief of the Bureau, C P Horne, Deputy Chief Engineer and Acting Chief of the Field Engineering Bureau.

The meetings are reported to have proceeded amicably and there were exchanges of viewpoints. Lew McCoy will be meeting along with General Counsel Booth with other members of the FCC staff to discuss regulatory and practical problems of repeaters. The League has asked for a six month extension for filing in the 220mc slice to the CB bands.

A Emergency Communications Advisory Committee has been established to join the groups for Contests, Repeaters and DX. A full list of the committees is in the September QST.
