Mt. ATHOS A report relayed from HB9KB passes the information that there will be another go at Mt. Athos next week-end, the plans calling for activity from about September 20-23rd.

SV1DB/A was a call-sign mentioned in the report. No further details are known but the assumption would be that it would follow the lines of the last effort with some changes to remedy some of the problems encountered on the previous effort.

After the last effort in April there had been an announcement that another effort would be scheduled for this Fall, possibly in September. It does seem that they are on schedule with this one.

Last time out 14195kc was the main SSB frequency and c.w. efforts were 5kc or 45kc above the band edges. In April there was also some activity around the 21275kc territory.

More details may surface but this one seems rather definite at this time.

JUAN FERNANDEZ No late word and the plans for K5QHS/CEØZ should be well on their way by this week-end with the possible opening on September 14th...give or take a day. The political situation in Chile would seem to be the biggest problem with a transport strike almost two months old and the commercial airline pilots joining in to support the strikers. Listen.....by the end of the week you should have the up-to-date story. Full details on frequencies in previous bulletins.

FARQUHAR There are continuing reports of a possible VQ9=Farquhar effort next month by a group from the Seychelles.

The reports are that VQ9BP plus five or six other operators will sail from Mahé in VQ9BPs yacht and will operate from Farquhar group southwest of the Seychelles.

VQ9BP has been active on fifteen, being worked by the middle states. At this point it might be pointed out that VQ9BP must be considered one of those ubiquitous Marin QRPers, being born and raised in Marin County here. There should be more information on this one before the end of the month.

SPRATLY There has been some talk by some of the participants in the 1S1A-Spratly effort of last February of another try at this garden spot in the South China Sea sometime next Spring after the monsoon season has passed. As one participant said: "We will return!". The return is to ease the suffering of the middle and eastern states who missed out last time.

SINT MAARTEN K2FJ, Ken Palmer, will be on Sint Maarten from October 23rd for a two week stay and will be signing PJ8DX. This will put him across the GQ WW Test and adds to the increasing activity that will surface from the Caribbean during this effort.

BRUNEI VS5MC, Maurice Caplan, has settled into some permanent quarters and expects to get some better antennas up. It may be noted that Maurice has had some TVI problems.

VS5MC and VS5LH are found frequently from 1200Z. VS5MC has been active on forty and both frequently are on the SEANET...14320kc/1200Z.

MORE SHORTLY NOTED

If you should wonder about those 4K1 Russian Stations, We have a chart of the Antarctic sent by G3RFG but cannot figure out how to reproduce it. If you work 5 of the KA6s you can get a certificate. They are often found around 14240kc from 1200Z. K2BT worked 9QCLP on twenty SSB recently. The fellow was looking for a phone patch into New York City. This is the registration for a ZAIRE aircraft and the fellow was cruising at 12 000 feet. 9X5NA keeps a schedule with W7LFA at 0400Z, usually about the 14200=14210kc country.

WWV is dropping Greenwich Time come January 1st.....they say they are going to 'Coordinated Universal Time'. Only the name will be changed, everything else will be the same.

Some working UK9AAN and UK9ABA recently have wondered who is the operator. At times the accent is definitely American.....often definitely not Russian. 5U7BA says that two more 5U7s will return to Niger from France the first week in September and will be teachers in the school system there. UK1ZFI QSLs still surfacing from some of the slower bureaus. Some have given up in despair. For a limited time the WCDXB will offer a different route. Send QSL with 6 IRCs and wait two months. The UK1ZFI QSL will surface....it has worked every time so far. Only for desperate cases, however. FR7AM seems to be the hard one to crack for QSLs. Here we tried writing direct, offering the outright bribe of the WCDXB gratis if he would split with some QSLs. What did he do? What sort of a day was it? A day like all days....FR7AM never bothered to answer any communications.

K6WR will be traveling in Europe soon....visiting some of the local DKers enroute. There have been some rumors that Wake Island and the KW6s might be completely inactivated. K7SAD/KW6 says this is not true. He is there doing some construction work and everything is normal. On the QSL information listed elsewhere for the Wake Island stations, the ZIP codes are different, in fact they are different than what the ZIP Code Directory shows for Wake Island. These must be unit addresses for military units and it would be best to use them and not be confused by the differences. One SEASIA type when queried about XU1AA and why didn't he go there to operate was very blunt in advising that he had no intention or desire to go there while the conditions were the way they were at present. W4KA advises that he is available for QSL Manager duties....ready to go with plenty of time.

That VS5LH used to be VR2FT. AC4RF of a few years back....twenty or so....is now located in Luanda, Angola for the British Foreign Office....he's the Consul-General there.

An UPI dispatch from Pago Pago a few weeks back told of a floating island of pumice ten miles long and eight miles wide twenty miles north of the Tongan Island of Niuafou. The layer of volcanic material was at least 18 inches thick. Where this new country came from is unknown, some airplane pilots reporting an eruption at sea in this area early in July.

As far as known, no call-sign has been assigned to this new one as yet. OH2BH is supposed to be in California later this month on business. The SoCal DX Club puts out DX information on Thursdays, 14220kc/0300Z at the present. Actually it is 8:00p.m. local time so the time may change next month. Anyhow, you can listen for updates on the important happenings.

We started off by mentioning that the mailings have passed the 800 mark each week. We knew it was coming but was not especially anxious to reach the mark. Somewhere along the way we may change things but not just yet. Time is always the most pressing factor and this week's bulletin was started on Thursday afternoon, then all day Friday until 8:00p.m., then all day Saturday from 7:30a.m. It will be in the mails about 6:00p.m. The problem is not one of news, we are convinced that there is more DX News floating around than there is time to print. Costs of paper have gone up sharply this year, but others are also reporting these increases.

## SUNSPOT LOUIE....

Some very unusual sunspot activity developed during the last week with several groups of sunspots developing. In addition on last Thursday and Friday there were reports of gigantic solar flares, some being so huge as to possibly affect communications and energy supplies on Earth.

The astronauts in SKYLAB have been reporting this unusual activity and changes have been occurring rapidly.

On the September 3rd chart six areas of activity will be noted, the largest spots being approximately 20,000 miles in diameter and the smaller ones about 7000 miles in diameter. Between the 3rd and 4th several spots disappeared and it is doubtful if all of these spots will live long enough to traverse the face of the sun.

Band conditions over the Labor Day week-end were exceptional with many good openings. It will be noted from Red Eyed Louie that African reports are starting to appear again, these reports having been scant for some months. Long path is returning and it would be incorrect to believe that the bands are dead because of an occasional check. The conditions change frequently and there have been some exceptional band openings. Even some 28mc activity on north-south paths.

As of Saturday, WWV was reporting "...fair to good, conditions quiet and forecast N-6".

MALPELO Further information on Malpelo planning does indicate that there is some serious thought being given to a possible effort sometime in the coming months and efforts are being made to solve both the political and logistical problems. Most of the planning is aimed at 1974 if all the problems can be solved. At this stage there is only preliminary work proceeding with plans for a multi-national effort being considered.

SHORTLY NOTED Okay, Men! Someone has been talking. Last week the WCDXB mailing went over the 800 mark. That's our theoretical limit. We figured it out on a slide-rule. We survived but we may run into problems if this inflation does not cease. Only tell your friends and deserving DXers.

This week we run eight sheets again. This really taxes us but we managed to survive though we cut some corners.

On these 8-page issues we really cut the corners on the foreign subscriptions. We actually trim off the margins to keep the weight inside the half-ounce limit. Not that there is an actual limit but the postage goes up rather disastrously on those foreign mailings when we cross the half-ounce barrier.

Speaking of the Post Office, we will say again. Airmail copies should be delivered anywhere within the lower forty-eight by Monday, the 1st class copies should be delivered no later than Tuesday. This is what the Post Office Department promises you ....95% or better on these delivery standards. If you are not reaching these standards with your copy, write a letter of complaint to the local Postmaster and ask him to foward it.

The Post Office does run a continual in-house audit of the mail service and the reports on these audits comes out every two weeks. If your Sectional Center did not make 95%-POW!! High level conferences and all that stuff. The problem is that some centers have not make the 95% minimum level of service for many months and somewhere along the way something....or someone....is going to go. There are feelers being launched for a possible rate increase....10¢ or even 15¢ for 1st class mail....but do not get excited over this yet. The mood of Congress in recent months has not been favorable for such moves and even though the Postal Service is nominally independent, there are still some facts of life to face. Anyhow, if you do not get your bulletin within the limits as mentioned above, write a letter of complaint. Don't phone.....write. You may tend to discount the effectiveness of this but be assured that it is effective. Write direct to the Postmaster General if the mood strikes you....
