

AVES The Venezulean government has granted a license, YV8AL, to the group on Aves Island and they will be active until the end of September. There is one stipulation attached to the license. The station can work anyone but are not to QSL for the contacts. It is thought that this stipulation is to continue the YV A AA O operations $^{\text {on }}$ by the Venezulean Radio Club as the primary source for Aves activity and DXCC credit. The club last operated in January 1973 and will be expected to schedule another operation in early 1976.
YV8AL can be expected to be found on the Caribbean Net at 1100 Z , 7158 kc the frequency. There may be other frequencies but this is the one where they can be found most days. On 75mtrs you should watch for YV8AI/YVめ at 3810kc from 0930 Z and 2200Z. On the matter of QSLs, work them first and worry later.

HAITI A new one in Port au Prince showed up last week, HH2OEA operated by Julio Silva. Julio apparently a Chilean and is in Haiti on a technical project for the Organization of American States....which may also explain the suffix in the call. Julio was at $21276 \mathrm{kc} / 1600 \mathrm{z}$ on September 18th. It is possible that he does not have a great deal of experience in working pile-ups but was learning fast. The rig is in his office there in Port au Prince and occasionally he has to QRT to answer the telephone.
Last week he was running a phone patch to his family in Santiago through CEJAQW. He had no QSL cards and for some initial contacts was making up a custom, one-of-akind QSI on a post card. His address is: Julio Silva, P.O. Box 1304, Port au Prince, Haiti。
Mt. ATHOS Up to Friday of last week, nothing solid had developed on this one and by this time you, should have figured out yourself what went on. Friday there was some reports relayed that Europeans were hearing the station; some reports said it was going to be C.W only; some saying that nothing was going to happen until Spring and that was it. -
COCOS-TI9 The Costa Rica government has been having some problems with Cocos, one report saying that they are aghast over 'hippy-types' running around the island clad in naught but some psyodelic flowers. The Costa Rica government has been prohibiting trips there $:$
Last month the "TICO TIMESM, a newspaper published in San Jose, Costa Rica, reported that there had been a declaration of independence in a hand-written document issued by the "Independent Free Government of Cocos Island". The letter was delivered to La NACION, another newspaper in San Jose and while the government was reported as not taking the declaration too seriously, they were thinking of sending a group out scouting and patrolling to see what was going on.
The 'Declaration of Independence' cited a list of grievances, one being repeated a number of times and that was the attitude of the Costa Rica government towards long hair. The last official visit to the island was in 1972 when the head of the Costa Rican narcotics squad went out to check things but broke his arm when landing through the surf. TI8PE, Boots, who operated there a few years back, has been thinking of making another run out there around the turn of the year to activate TI8=Cocos again.

SUNSPOT LOUIE Frorn September 12th througi 16t: thore was no significant sunspots and the spoty showa on this weeks chart appeared on the 17th. It is a small spot, approximately 8000 miles in: diameter and, since it is rather light in colory, it might not be too active. However, ever fith this low sunspot activity, there have been good openings during morning and evenings and itwin 11 be noted that 75 reter reports are showing up. in quantity and even some 10meter reports on norti-solith. pathé" The mean number of sunspots observed in July was $20.8 \%$ on this, wo expected to contique to decline in the coming months during the down portion oI Whe sunspot cycle. Comet Kohoutek will get increasing publicity in the comirg monthis and the next SKYLAB crew is having its mission changed to concentrate on the observation of the comet. SKYLAB 4 will be launched around November 9 th and will run into January. There is a possibility of the launch being delayed until later in November to allow for more observations. The conet should become visible in late November and will swing around the sun on December 28th. Scientists are still not quite sure how lngg its orbit is. Some estimate say it may be 10,000 years, some say $\dagger$ million years with the 80,000 year orbit being considered a good guess. Some figure that it may be just passing through and will never return. Anyhow, be prepared for some spectacular sights as it approaches the sun.

IRRL etc The FCC turned down the ARRI request for an extension for filing comments on the z2Onc matter. The FCC order noted that the proceedings were to determine whether additional CB frequencies were needed, nc to explore Class D-Citizen Band enforcement problems:
The ARRL has filed a petilition that asks the FCC to givé a second chance without the payment of an additional, fee for applicants who fail the code test the first time. WAFIZI has petitioned the FCC to permit high-seas operation in $3500-3800 \mathrm{kc}$ and 7100 kc to 7300 kc . Motor Vehicle Manufacturers Assn in Detroit are sponsoring a study of the interforence by motor vehicles to rad: o oommunication.


FORMOS $\Lambda$ Sone weeks back there was a mention of Richard Brown, WלOL, being assigned to Formosa and his working on possible activity there. Things have not developed as he had hoped. However, Dick has not relaxed his drive to get on the air from BV2-. The Ministry of National Defense there advised that under their law poraission shall not be given to a foreign resicant to operate a radio station within the country. Thus, the request could not be favorably considered.
However, WOOI has not given up the good fight. There does appear to be some possibility of reactivation of a club licens with WめOL as trustee, the station to be on the U.S. military compound at Taipei. Presently he is working on this with the hope of activating BV2US, even volunteering his own gear to get the station on the air. It is possible that permission to operate under such an arrangement might be obtained in the coming months. Another indicator of some slight relaxation is the permission given to WA1MQV to sign WATMQV/BV/mra aboard the USS TUSK (SS426) which will be turned over to the Taiwan government on October 18th. While the submarine will become the HAI-PAO in October, the permission is good until May 1974. Keep watching.... something may develop.
