More information on the A55KV effort will be developing during December but the goal to open up there remains late in Docorber with Janaury 1st tlie target date.
KMARAN To elaborate on the cryptic information of last week, the permission for $4 W 1 A F$ and FIBOM to land on Kamaran was revoked. The situation in the area is very volatile and there are silso some problems existing between the two Yemens. Klaus and Reiner have not given up hope-and may try to revive the plans after the turn of the year. There are a lot of 'ifs' in any plans to put VSgK-Korraran on the air ond matters will have to break just right for anything to be successful. The plus factors in the situation are that there are two experienced DXers in the area who wish to go to Kanaran and will if things are favorable.

SAN AIFDRES A group of W9s will be on San Andres late in December and plgn to operate from Fixd-San Andres until mid-January. Plans include 160 meter operations as well as action on other bands. More should develon on this later.

Comet Kohoutck should start showing up with increasing brilliance in the coming weck, being visible in the castern skies before dawn. All the discussions tend to confirn that this will be a spectacular sight towards the end of December. Attempts to copy WWV on Saturday morning were futile. However, conditions in the contest apeared to be fair during the opening stages and on Saturday morning some fairly long haul DX was showing.
