CHAGOS WB2NUO will be on Diego Garcia in the Chagos Group starting this January and will be there for a year. Initially he is planning action on $10 / 15 / 20 \mathrm{mtrs}$ and may move to the lower frequencies when he gets settled. The call-sign probably will be WE2VUO/VQ9.

SPRATMY There are plans going on for a possible repeat operation from Spratly this coming February with some of those who went there last February doubling back for another go at stirring things up. Indicators are that possibly some operators from the states will make the trip out. to SEAsia to participate in the trip. Possibly more will develop on this in the coming weeks.
CAMBODIA Don Riebhof, HS3DR, plus a few others are putting XU1AA on the air this month and there have been a number of reports of the station being active after $1300 Z$. During the last week the station was reported in the $14310-14320 \mathrm{kc}$ country right after the time for the SEAnet operations at 14320 kc at 1200 Z and later on in the 14210ke area.

POSTAGE...SUBSCRIPTIONEEC Are the postage rates going up in january? Maybe yes.... Maybe no. And there has been no decision on the matter yet. The whole thing has to clear the Cost of Living Council and as of this week it still had not gotten by that group and some indications of worry that it might not.
The Postal Service has stocked a lot of $2 \varnothing$ stamps anticipating the rate increase, some new lox commemoratives and a new 136 airmail has been announced and everything is 'Go except for the permission to go.
The way things go, the-Postal Service pioposes the increase to the Postage Rate Comitission, an independent rate-fixing ody. This group may act or it may not. If if fails to act in 90 days the Postal Service can put the proposed rate into being as a temporary increase. The 90 days in this case is up January 5th. One letter on the matter recently noted the problem in converting the stamp vending machines over to the new rates....last time it took six months to complete....and put forth the thought that ...! surely if the $10 \varnothing$ 'ate is not approved they. surely will give us $9 \neq$. They will, won't they? Won't they?". As of this last weekend, nothing was sure.
