AC4-TIBET AC4-Tibet, an area which vanished under some expansion plans in an Asian League some decades back, will join the list of deleted countries shortly, the indicators being that AC4-Tibet will be announced as deleted in the June QST

SAUDI/KUWAIT NEUTRAL ZONE The Wall Street Journal last week carried an article on the plans for some U.S. oil companies to expand their operations in the Middle East. The Getty Oil Company and the American Independent Oil Company indicated that they are planning to expand their operations in the Saudi/Kuwait Neutral Zone. Both of these companies are producing in the partitioned Neutral Zone and the companies are discussing new explorations and developments. Some of this activity is close to the Wafra area, and in the Ratawi field in the Neutral Zone.

Union Oil Company has apparently signed an agreement with Egypt for oil exploration in the Red Sea area and they will be doing exploratory work in the Cape Ras Benas area in the Red Sea.

A 9X- Effective April 19th the MP4B-call sign for Bahrein was changed to A 9X-, the A 9-block of calls being assigned to Bahrein by the ITU. Mike Graham, whose MP4BJR call has been heard these many months, will be signing AX9C as his new call.

FRED LAUN—LU5HFI The condition of Fred Laun continues good and early last week he was speaking on the telephone in a brief conversation and he was in good spirits. It was indicated that he probably will have to have one more operation and a long period of convalescence, possibly up to sixty days. However, he does seem to be definitely on the mend and possibly may be heard from in the near future. Some of the amateurs in the Canal Zone area who have called the hospital have indicated that it was not possible to get through and that security is probably rather tight. But the word that most amateurs were looking for is that Fred is on the road to recovery

VIETNAM Two additional amateur radio stations have been authorized in Viet Nam, the talls being XV5AA and XV5AB. These have been approved by the government of South Viet Nam and the necessary letters have been forwarded to the ITU stating that the stations are legal

LORD HOWE Karl Gamper, VECRA, will be leaving the radio station in Yellowknife in June on a leave that probably will run about two months. Karl is intending to make a trip to VK4-Lord Howe Island and stir some activity from that spot. The plans are definite as to intent but not definite as to dates. Karl will possibly have another trip to the hospital on this leave and then will make the trip. The schedule at the hospital will determine the Lord Howe operation but it will be either June or July. More should surface on this soon.

VKLAK operated there some months back and while he did not work many W/Ks from Lord Howe, he did manage some QSOs in other directions. Don Brickey, @70K, in Las Vegas is the QSL Manager for VKLAK and while there were not a multitude of contacts, the ones that were made can be QSLed to Don.

W70K also advises that Gil, VK4AK, will be retiring in the early part of next year and is considering another trip to Lord Howe to keep the island on the air for a bit. While somewhat remote, there is scheduled air service from Australia to Lord Howe.

SUNSPOT LOUIE ... The last of the spots shown on Last weeks chart, and which had been around for better than ten days, disappeared to the back of the Sun on April 19th. No new spots appeared up to the time of this observation and the bands above 7mc did reflect these conditions. WWV has been broadcasting a number of signals, Last week there were N5s and 6s and some U5s As of mid-day Friday WWV was broadcasting No for a forecast.

In the bulletin of the Royal Astronomical Society of Canada for this month, Covington indicates some divergent views. The study of the solar radio flux in the 10.7cm region, that would be about 2800mhz, indicate that the low point for the present sunspot cycle will occur about January 1975 with an observed period of 10,5 years for the cycle. There is general agreement that this is the bottom point of the 88 year cycle but some feel that the next high in the sunspot cycle will come on schedule and the sunspots will top out in the 75 to 100 spot region. Next high may be even slightly lower, in the 50-75 sunspot category.

To bring things up to date, the mean sunspot number for January was 27.4 according to American observers and 29.3 by the Zurich count. The count was predicted to be 32 in April: 21 in May and 19 in June. Things are slipply slowly but most know that already.

ARRL Etc Some have inquired of the ARRL as to what would be the status of the BY4SK QSLs, that operation being in September 1965. The ARRL DXCC Desk replies say that the FCC notice on the Republic of China was a recent date one and there would appear to be no problems as concerns the credits for BY4SK

The FCC has denied the ARRLs request for a second extension of the comment date on the Amateur Satellite Service Inquiry, Docket 19852.

RM-2349 is the reference assigned to the petition to release the restriction on the linking of repeaters.

RM-2148 asking that the FCC drop the requirement of a topographical map in a repeater application was dismissed, the FCC pointing out that it solved the problem back in January by making much requirements part of the station log rather than the application.

The ARRL has further commented on the FCC China ban but there is a lot of speculation and little fact available on this one. Everyone reads the words but does not understand the language.

W20VC...the Million Dollar Station There has not as yet been a decision though the action continues. It is reported that the complaining neighbors tried to get the lacal municipal authorities involved but they steered clear. A local newspaper reporter has been looking for the story and was advised by some FCC spokemen that the problem often is the fault of the TV manufacturers. WORLD RADIO is expected to carry a full story on the tower case in an early edition. Meanwhile, any one wanting to help carry the fight through the courts can direct any communication to the Harmonic Hills Radio League, 23 New Street, Katonah, New York, 10536.
