

KINGMAN REEF The picture on any possible Kingman Reef action cleared during the last week with a group from the Northern California DX Club announcing that they will be seeking to put KP6KR on the air from mid-June.

As of last week-end the plans were rather definite with but a final matter of some of the transportation problems to be worked out. The tentative plans at this time are to open from Palmyra signing KP6PA on June 19th and to open from Kingman Reef with KP6KR opening up on about June 20th. There would be almost a week of operating with the operation due to close down on the following Tuesday or Wednesday.

Several of the Northern California DXers in on the initial planning include K6AHV, W6OAT WASUCE/6, and WB6OOL. Plans call for some of the operators and gear to leave Hawaii by boat about June 7th, proceeding via VR3-Fanning and then to Palmyra. The rest of the group will be flying direct from Honolulu to Palmyra and are scheduled to leave Honolulu on June 19th, arriving the same day on Palmyra.

The costs for the DXpedition to Kingman Reef are largely being underwritten by the Northern California DX Foundation. Transportation costs are considerable and actually constitute the major portion of the expenses. QSLs will also be handled by the Northern California DX Foundation and will go to Box 717, Oakland, Calif. 94604. For those wishing to locate Kingman Reef, it is at 6 N and 162 W. Chart 5357 will give you information on the reef, mostly that it is under water at low tide and that

the highest point is 3 feet above sealevel.

The other groups interested in a possible Kingman Reef operation apparently have dropped out, landing permission seems to have been their problem. The Northern California group through one of their representatives in Hawaii did get permission from the Headquarters of the U.S. Pacific Fleet to enter the Kingman area, the Third Fleet being the administrative office for the Kingman area.

Some of the other groups making application to other bureaus were denied permission, the reasons being given being concern for the safety of the individuals. One such letter said that Kingman Reef was a very dangerous place for even experienced seamen to land a vessel and many ships have been lost in that area.

It was also pointed out that not too much is known about the Kingman area, the first survey being made and chart published in 1927 and the only correction to this chart was made in 1947.

The ARRL DXCC Desk has indicated that any proper Kingman Reef activity will be approved for new country status. The only stipulation being made is that there be Navy clearance for the landing on the Reef.

The Northern California DX Club group plans to work all bands, SSB and CW and to mount an around-the-clock operation. More information on frequencies will be surfacing in the coming weeks.

This effort possibly marks the move of the Northern California DX Foundation into some sizeable DX effort. At the present time there are a number of other projects being considered and something on these should be surfacing shortly. The list of possible projects is considerable and includes both short and long range planning. As of last week-end, this Northern California DX Club effort appeared to be the only survivor in the effort to put Kingman Reef on the air for a new one and their planning was well down the road to becoming a reality.

SUNSPOT LOUIE Conditions have fluctuated during the last week, some days with good conditions and some with poor ones. The line of sunspots that ranged across the face of the sun in last weeks chart was gone by the time of the May 12th observation, just one spot remaining and that quickly disappearling. WWV has been reporting various forecasts, some N-7s and some U-5s. Often these change during a day. While the sunspot activity was around early in May there was very good hand conditions with some all-night good conditions on twenty. It might

At the present time the matter is at the examination before trial level and probably will be before the Superior Court in White Plains sometime in June. Financing the long legal fight is increasingly expensive and letters asking for some support are going out from the Harmonic Hill Radio League this week seeking some financial assistance. The address of the Harmonic Hills bunch is Box 73, Katonah, New York 10536 and all help will be appreciated. While the ARRL is interested from an over-all legal and precedent angle, the League's policy does not include financial assistance. However, it will be noted that the Executive Committee at their Washington meeting early this month did give some attention to tower cases.

In about four or five weeks he will again be hospitalized for some surgery to do some intestinal hook-up which still needs to be done.

ARRL EX BOARD The ARRL Executive Board met in Washington on Saturday, May 11th, and talked about a number of things.

For one thing, they voted into Life Membership about 950 applicants for the exalted state. Approval was voted for an exhibit on amateur radio satellite activity for the John F Kennedy Space Center in Florida. Reimbursed the Amateur Satellite Corporation in the amount of \$1282.58 for miscellaneous expenses in the 1st quarter of 1974 and also voted to reimburse the Radio Amateur Satellite Corporation for additional amounts beyond February 28, 1974 for assistance in the OSCAR 7 project, up to the maximum amount authorized by the ARRL Board of Directors, or \$38,000.00

The Executive Committee examined a draft of a proposed revision of the long-standing ARRL agreement with the Red Cross, and authorized the President to conclude the agreement.

Directed the General Counsel to file comment in FCC Docket 19973 indicating general approval but requesting a portion of each amateur band above 40 GHZ be made available on an exclusive basis.

The Executive Committee also discussed a number of matter including a possible rise in League dues, the forthcoming allocations conference, Congressional bills, amateur tower cases, W1AW operations, IARU travel plans, OSCAR 7, a rise in the Handbook price, affiliated club questionaire forms and developments at the meeting with FCC officials and staff and the previous day, Friday May 10th.

June 15th or thereabouts by Northern California DX Group. OH2BH & Co....lst part of July. (OH3SA and OH1VR from OJØ from May 27th VR1AA was due to open up last week from VR3..... VESRA planning some activity this summer .... dates indefinite.

Some of the JAs...JA3DJ/JA3DWT and JA3GZN of the JA DX Club, have been looking BHUTAN for permission for an A51 operation and had been aiming for the first part of this month. However, as in other instances, the government there in Bhutan is not giving any operating permission. In a letter to the group they advised that no permission would be given "...because of His Majesty's coming coronation". The efforts by VU2KV and W6KNH around the turn of the year were also stymied by the same problem of getting permission and the indicators are that nothing would be done until after the coronation. Entry permission into Sikkim was also the problem for a possible AC3 operation due to some problems within the country and a concern over any outsiders visiting Sikkim. The monsoon season will soon be in the Himalayas and there should be little possible action until this Fall. While W6KNH and VU2KV have not given up their hopes for some activity, Venkat is presently headed for G-land and will be in 6-land late in May. There is the possibility of the VK group there to Televise the coronation getting some action but this is hardly a definite thing. It will be noted in the newspapers that there is considerable political unrest in that part of Asia...and elsewhere and often there is reluctance to let anyone in who might upset the uneasy calm that prevails.

SOUTH SHETLANDS There has been a report that CE9AT from the South Shetland group is sometimes found around 14195kc from 2130Z...sometimes in a QSO with CE6EZ. There have been nothing noted in reports to Red Eyed Louis but it might be a possibility.

MIAMI TORISHIMA JA8IEV, Masa, will be on Marcus for some months, his tentative arrival being mid-May and he should be there until mid-August. Masa plans to be active on all bands but will concentrate on 40/80mtr C.W. He will probably be signing JASIEV/JD1 and look for him on the low edges of the bands. All QSLs will go to JA8JL...and his latest QTH goes as follows

W5GJ Max Don K5AAD ?W5MBB Mary  CHINA There have been no further reports on the planned BY operation of last month and it would be a fair assumption to feel that the FCC edict, and other problems put the whole plan on the shelf.

We checked with the Peking Desk and they report that there was no sign that W1GEY arrived in Peking and that a monitoring of twenty meters did not evidence any BY activity.

At this time the feeling in Peking is that while the door is not closed tightly against amateur activity in China, it is also definitely not open and there would seem to be little reason to expect any amateur operations in the near future. There are some there on the scene who are working when possible to get some BY activity and these could be on the air very quickly should there be any government permission but this is not anticipated at this time.

One observeror, in commenting on possible BY-activity, noted that the Chinese are too independent and proud to accept any 'gifts' from outsiders unless there was a good way that they in turn could return the favor. This comment would tend to support the advice of previous reports by those close to the picture that any BY activity is most likely to come with Republic of China nationals and not any outsiders. Things do change and what at times might seem to be impossible obstacles often do change with time.

What can you do? Practice the patience routine. It will bring great comfort and build the character and one of these days you may work a BY...
