DESROCHES The departure of the VQ9-group from the Seychelles enroute to Desroches is rather solid now for September 7th and the previously announced opening date of September 9th should hold good.

Another operator has been added to the effort. VQ9DC, Diana Cardell, will go and should be the first YL operator to be on the air from there. Back in Mahe, VQ9MI, John Cardell, will provide for local communications with the Desroches group. It all goes as planned, Desroches should open next Monday for a two week run. Be Prepared!!

BAJA NUEVO A Baja Nuevo effort has been scheduled for the last part of November and the planning at this time includes WA6AHF, WA6OEY and KZ5JF. There is a possibility that others including HB/BKX will also be in on the effort. The itinerary at this time calls for a departure by boat from Panam about the 24th of November. A run to San Andres to pick up some gear and possibly the fourth operator, HK/BKX, and then the run to Baja Nuevo. Both CW and SSB will be used, eighty through ten meters. Gear will include Collins 30L-1 linears. Presently the group is looking for the last piece of gear and they need a light, tri-band beam. WA6AHF would like to hear from anyone who might be able to assist in this area. On Forty and Eighty they will use dipoles. More will be surfacing on this in the next month or two. The group should be on the air, if all plans jell, during the week following the CQ WW CW DX Test in November.

SUDAN ST2AY is a new station on from Sudan and Roger, the operator, should be there in Khartoum for the next year to eighteen months. Previously Roger was in Libya but was unable to get on the air because of the prohibition on amateur radio which goes back to about 1967. He is using Drake gear to a Yaesu linear with a cubical quad antenna 30 feet above a second story flat-top. Roger will be looking for an ST2 contact while in Khartoum; he still needs that one for his DXCC. Last week he was in the lower portion of twenty phone and from around 2000Z. One day he was reported at 14202kc from 1945Z and on another day was at 14210kc from 2000Z. His address is Post Office Box 4142, Khartoum, Sudan.

OKELAUS No late word on any new developments. 5W1AL was at the last report still in Western Samoa and hoping for the October boat. The group still had to acquire some needed gear which may necessitate a quick trip back stateside. 5W1AL often at or about 14243kc from 0300Z or thereabouts. Often you may find him chatting with his girl friends back home. As Lord Baden-Powell would often say on those dark nights on the veldt: "Some nights sure are long".

NAURU JA1OCA should be available this week signing C21DX from Nauru. Look for the station on these frequencies.

SHORTLY NOTED For some time we have not been exactly satisfied with the method we were using to reproduce the WCDXB and with this issue we are trying to master the off-set printing route. You may get some idea from these pages how the effort went and how much success we had. Frankly, we are learning off-set printing pretty much the way we learned Amateur Radio....from a book.

For over six years or so we churned out the bulletin on an ancient Rex Rotary mimeograph machine. It was not that the machine was not willing, it was a bit old and tired but it did run several million sheets of copy through it in the labors on behalf of the WCDXB. And even though there were times when we had to repair the machine in mid-run, it did serve well. A bit messy at times and able to consume an inordinate amount of ink, but it did its part and we are hoping that the new method of printing will be an improvement.

Those CY-prefixes which were out of Canada during August were used in connection with an International French Youth Festival held in Quebec.

GC8HT maintains from Guernsey a Sunday schedule and this Sunday will be at or about 14243kc from 0800Z looking for W/Ks. If this does not suit you, Dick will be active next week on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday from 0000Z to 0200Z and on Friday it will be the watch for the W/Ks again. Should these times not be your favorites, you might send an SAE/IRC to GC8HT and you will get his operating schedule which lines out his plans all the way to June '75.

Guernsey along with Jersey are part of the Channel Islands off the Coast of France. Each an independent Bailiwick, they being the Bailiwick of Guernsey and the Bailiwick of Jersey, part of the British Dominions, each a Crown Dependency and while regarded as part of the British Isles, they are not thought of as part of the United Kingdom. The closest spot on France is 21 miles across the Channel from England. Guernsey is 70 miles away and is considered as 'overseas' from the United Kingdom. Anyhow, GC8HT is going strong at 72 years and is frequently active on several bands.

With the latter calls they were at Santa Tecla. UA0NT is looking for Vermont, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Montana to fill out a WAS. Jay says he will be around 14220kc from 1300Z on weekends looking for fillers. That PZ0CJ station for the Boy Scouts Caribbean Jamboree QSLs to Box 566, Paramaribo. Work two other PZ-stations during the Jamboree and you qualified for a special certificate.

5V7PW is new in Atakpame and apparently is Peter, ex-5V4PW in Togo. He can be QSLed to DJ1AW. He should be in Togo until September mid-month. Club Station UK1ZAA will be putting UA30MU on the air November 1st to memorialize an important date in the Great War. It will be used again on May 9, 1975. In Sweden a special 7SL-prefix will be used to the end of the year. Like 7SL7AN for example.
