CHAD 9G1AT is working over some plans to operate in Chad next week, the period will be around September 8th or 9th if all items jell.

Gene plans to be there signing TT5AC for about nine days. He says to look for him around 14025-14030kc from 1900Z to around 2300Z. This is the same call that Chester used some months back. More information may be coming through for the next issue.

GILBERT AND ELLICE ISLANDS Dan Lockyer, VR1AA, who handles the P&T at Betio on Tarawa in the Gilberts, writes:

I can confirm rumours that on 1st January 1976 there will be complete political separation between the Gilberts and Ellices. The latter are renaming themselves 'TUVALU' and the prefix VR8 has been assigned.

We think VR1AT will become VR8A but official confirmation is awaited. By any standards, this should be approved by ARRL as a new one. The Ellice Islands will have their own government, own civil service, own stamps and own money and are several hundreds of miles from adjoining territories. But of course this is a matter for the ARRL.

The existing 'Gilbert and Ellice Islands Colony' Administration will continue to administer what is to be called "The Gilbert Islands". In fact, this will be the Gilberts, Ocean Island, Phoenix Group and the Northern, Central and Southern Line Islands.

MORE NEW ONES!! A week or so ago there was mention of Bougainville going independent and W5AK passes along some more information, this being a comment from BARRON's WEEKLY in their August 11th issue:

MICRO-NATIONALISM continues to ravage emergent young nations. The provincial Government of Bougainville Island, where a RTZ affiliate mines the world's biggest copper ore-body, announced it would secede from Papua-New Guinea on September 1st, just a fortnight before Papua-New Guinea gains its national independence. Similarly, political leaders in Cabinda, an enclave within the Congo that belongs to Angola, proclaimed their independence, even before the fate of Angola is settled. Gulf Oil has an offshore field in Cabinda and could soon be producing nearly 500 million barrels a year. The two companies concerned were duly accused by Leftists of having fomented these two instances of micro-nationalism for their own benefit.

In fact, most international corporations well remember the disappointments which Union Miniere suffered with Moise Tshombe and his secession from the Belgian Congo. They are unlikely to promote pocket-handkerchief micro-states which now will have to face wards of secession, waged by central governments that cannot afford to forego the revenues from, respectively, copper and oil.

Parochial (not to say tribal) egoism is explanation enough for these political adventures. That fact was underscored by last week's events in the Comores

SUNSPOT LOUIE One sunspot was present at the time of this observation, the spot having erupted sometime between the 24th and 25th. Prior to this one showing, no sunspot had been visible since August 14th.

This sunspot is rather small, approximately 8000 miles in diameter and is moderately active as indicated by it's color shade. There has been no perceptible change in this spot since it was first seen. It will be rotating to the back side of the sun on August 29th.

WWV has been giving N-6 forecasts for the two days proper to this observation and there have been some good openings.

W4UMF takes a calculated look at the conditions up to the middle of September and these, added to the previous forecasts, come up with something like---

The Scientific American September 1975 issue is devoted to the Solar System with an article on "The Sun". The September QST has another in its series of articles on the matter of forecasts, this being: "The DXers Crystal Ball" by Ed Tilton, W1HDQ.

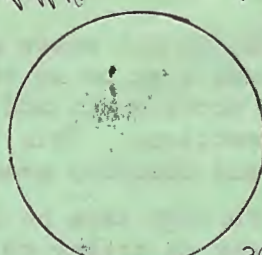
In this third article on the subject, W1HDQ raises the question whether or not we hit the bottom of Cycle 20 this late Spring, noting that during the ten day period of June 6th to 15th, the solar flux being at 66.1 during that period. W1HDQ notes a number of references and previous articles on this matter and it would be well to read the whole article.

Those who fear that DX is moribund might note the report given by K4KQ wherein he reports that in one hour of listening, with one sweep of the dial tuning from 14080kc to 14025kc and with the beam on Europe, he identified 54 DX stations in 22 countries.

MORE SUNSPOT LOUIE Things seem to be happening on the sun and no sooner than we had gotten the previous page all nailed down when another report came through from W8ZOK. He writes: "After I mailed you the report yesterday, a new spot erupted. It was elongated and slightly diffused. It is approximately 25,000 miles in length and 7000 miles wide. This is the left hand chart."

Archipelago off Madagascar. Paris wants to set the islands free but one of them, Mayotte, refuses to accept domination by its neighbors. A unilateral declaration of independence was followed by a coup d'etat that left the situation obscure. The Comores are hosts to no multinational corporations. They are dirt-poor and have no strategic importance. That latter consideration, however, lies behind another case of micronationalism: the growing move for secession of the Azores from Portugal. If Lisbon went Red, the Isles would have something more precious than copper or oil to found their autonomy; their strategic location.

Arch at this point is aiming for mostly C.W on 20/40/80mtrs though some QRP SSB is possible. The call sign is not certain as yet but may possibly be ZK2AP or ZK2AQ. More will be coming on this one.

SHORTLY NOTED The Arkansas DX Net meets at 0100Z on Mondays and Fridays....at or about 3815kc, give or take a kc or so to dodge the QRM. This is the official version, we have dodged about a bit and have heard some DXers looking for the Net because of other directions. This time converts to 8:00p.m. Central Daylight Savings Time on Sunday and Thursday evenings.

UK9AAN who often booms through says he is using a seven element beam on twenty. One of the Suffering Sixes is trying to locate the present address...or whereabouts of Howard Mansfield who was signing XV5DA a couple of months back. Some are still lighting a candle in hope of a FG7AM/Glorioso QSL but there have been no recent reports of anyone prying a QSL out of this one.

A few years back we did get the address of the Wing Commander who was VS9AWR and he was then with the RAF in Belgium, G3FKM locating him. There are again inquiries on this one and if anyone knows where he may be, the information is still needed for some tardy QSLing. Also needed is the present address of Kelly McCamy who was 601KM in August of 1969.

On that New England DX Meeting, now the word is that the scrod is 'broiled' and not 'boiled'. Son of a Gun!! POST OFFICE ITEMS If you are bracing for some reference to the postage rates and possible increases, relax...for the time being. We are still waiting for the word though the alert is to watch for some changes this coming week-end. This would be for present rates, not future rates.

There was an inquiry from one of the Deserving DXers as to why his letter from Gibraltar was nicked for 30¢ on delivery when there was already half the rate on the letter. A simple answer is a bit complex.

The regulations of the Universal Postal Union, a letter headed for another country is 'T' stamped for a charge double the amount of deficient postage, multiplied by the ratio between the charge adopted for letters at the first weight step by the country of origin. Thus you will see something like:

on your letter and this may explain why the letter when delivered will have a charge which is more than

what it would have been if it bore the proper rate when

first put in the mails. This is not an unusual question and often does come up.

And you may ask at some Post Offices and not be able to get a lucid explanation.

That's what we're running at you right now....if you did not recognize it. All of it comes from the Universal Postal Union and is not just a U.S. regulation.

The new IRCs need not be stamped to be valid. This is an optional matter but it does bring a lot of questions. The old ones did....but! In cases where the IRC was not stamped by the issuing office, it may be accepted if there is no doubt as to its authenticity. This is in the U.S. Postal Service International Manual. If is a U.S. IRC, you probably will have problems. A foreign IRC probably will get a more favorable reception.

The older type of IRCs go obsolete the end of this year. If you have a supply on hand, you should cull out the older ones and get rid of them and retain the new style IRC.

MORE SHORTLY NOTED The last schedule by W1AM with XT2AA did not jell but Art is still lining up the faithful. Send a sase for the mail-alert to W1AM...and it is usually Fridays at 2200Z at 14265kc.

The FCC in mid-July held a Future Planning Conference to consider related aspects of communications for the next twenty years. The topics covered: Spectrum Management, Inter-modal Competition, International Data Transmission, Computer-Communications Interface, Technological Developments and Future Planning, Rural Telecommunications, Limited Deregulation of Radio in Major Markets, Problems of Pricing/Cost Allocation/Cross-Subsidy, Private Citizen Use of Two-way Radio, UHF Television and FCC Research in Planning and Policy. W3OKN attended on behalf of the ARRL and zeroed in on "Private Citizen Use of Two-Way Radio" as the session to be monitored.

The ARRL issued a bulletin on the deletion of Sikkim and Blenheim Reef effective July 1, 1975. This will also be found on Page 91 of the September QST...delivered here in the Western Reaches on August 27th.

Ed DeYoung, VK4OR, is still pushing on his Hutt River Principality trip for the holiday season. The Australian Press does give a lot of attention to this secessionist movement in Western Australia and Prince Leonard keeps the movement going. The newspapers last week carried another item about another farmer in the Sydney area 'seceding' from Australia after a local dispute.

That VK4OR call will be official for Ed in October. Presently he is signing VK4ABA and is often found on 40/20 cw/ssb from 0730Z to around 1200Z plus checking in to the Pacific DX Net at 14265kc/0600Z on Tuesdays and Fridays.

A big DX Dinner was held in Helsinki on August 23rd with OH2BH/SM5SB/PA9WRR expected to be there.

HYERES ISLANDS During the WAE Test, actually it will be an operation either on September 12-15th or Sept 19-22nd, F0BKI/p will be scheduled by I2CBM and I2YDX from the Hyeres Islands...43°N, 6°30'E. This will count in the IOTA- EU 70 and they say to watch 3785kc/7085kc/14185kc for SSB and 3545kc/7045kc/14045kc for c.w. QSLs will go to I2YDX, Box 4, 21100, Hyeres, Italy.
