CHINA Last November LA1SH/BY was heard shortly and some skepticism was expressed as to whether this was actually in China or Dairen Slim. K6ZR reports that he has received a QSL for a twenty meter c.w. contact and marked: "Dairen (Peoples Republic of China).

There are also rumors about callsign being issued by the Peoples Republic and operating permission having been granted. This is all interspersed with even darker rumors that some Big Gun DXers are all in on the knowledge so that they will be ready to protect their interests when the station comes on the air..... After running all of this around the track a couple of times, one must admit that it makes interesting reading....... The rumor about the BY-license refers not to LA1Sप.

MACAO Reports relayed out of Hong Kong says that Horacio Torres, CR5AJ, is now in Macao and has been operating on fifteen meters signing CR9AJ.
Some of the VS6-stations have been urging him to come up on twenty meters and the indicators are that this may come shortly.

IRAN EP2SN advises that he will be on every Wednesday/Thursday/Friday looking for the states and especially those states he needs to complete his WAS. Generally he will be found around 14025 kc for c.w. operations and in the $14215 \mathrm{kc}-14220 \mathrm{kc}$ zone for SSB. Look for him from $1430 Z$ to 1530Z.
Presently he neds Idaho/Utah/Wyoming/Montana and North Dakota. QSLs go to WA3BZA.
IRAQ W3ACE, Hank Meyer, who once signed YIZAM, was a speaker at the recent W9DXCC meeting. He reported being in Baghdad some months back and visited the top man for radio affairs there in Iraq. W3ACE mentioned the amateur radio situation.
The radio official was interested and thought that a VI-Iraq DXpedition might be possible, even a matter of good public relations. So W3ACE applied for a license to operate in Iraq.
It was rejected!!
It took a long time to get to higher authorities but'definitely it was rejected. The internal feeling within Iraq is changing and the attitudes towards those from the western nations is and has changed. However, the situation at this time has hot progressed sufficiently so that early activity might be expected. However, there are those who are cautiously optimistic that something may develop in the future. Practice your patience!!
EQUATORIAL GUINEA Some problems have surfaced, the main sticker being that the local contact man in Equatorial Guinea has apparently split suddenly from the local scene there leaving things a bit mudded.
If things settle down, the 3C2DX may still be heard. If the hoped for improvements do not come, it may be EA8CR all the way through the contest.......

SUNSPOT LOUIE Another week has come and gone with no significant sunspot activity. Some rain along with the cloud cover has prevented some observation but on the day of the report and the two previous days, observations were possible and they revealed nothing.
Even without the solar activity, there have been some fairly good openings on 21 mc and the lower frequencies. WWV was forecasting $N-6$ the day of this report and it had been $N=5$ the two previous days.

WWV is forecasting an minor ionospheric storm
for the period October 6 th to 10th. The return to a quiet status is expected to come around October 12th. forecast into next year, WWV is still holding to the
WHUMF notes that the recentsunspot activity has been close to the splan equator which wouln imficate that it is tied to the cycle now ending and not to the new cycle which will come. Activity on new cycles is relatively high in latitude on the sun and tends to womk jown closer to the equator as the cycle comes towards its end and the start of the 2 jllowing cycle. WWY's semi-monthly median projection for the first half of October is for a SSN of 14 .

TRANSKEI REPUBLIC Things are still moving towards independence of this black homeland in South Africa and the present Transkei Parliament would be dissolved immediately after the new state celebrates its independence a year from now in October 1976.

The new country would be called the Republic of Transkei and would have a black president. The present Chief Minister of Transkei, Mr Matanzima emphasized that the new republic would never become a one-party state. It's government will be modeled along that of South Africa.

NEW COUNTRY Papua-New Guinea went independent September 15 th and will join the list of deleted countries. However, it came back as a new country effective September 16th though DXCC credit will not be given until January lst. You will find a number of P29s listed in Red Eyed Louie this week. The whole bit of information on these changes will be in the December QST.
Newspapers recently have carried mention of 'Tuvalu' going independent. The WCDXB of September 2nd has an item by VR1AA on this. Newspaper accounts say that the new "能uvalu' will have a population of about 7000 people and that the action will be taken because the Ellice Island people, who are polynesian, fear domination by the micronesian people who constitute the majority of the population in the former Gilbert and Ellice Groups. VR8 is expected to be the prefix for 'Tuvalu' come January lst.
