

CHINA Last November LA1SH/BY was heard shortly and some skepticism was expressed as to whether this was actually in China or Dairen Slim. K6ZR reports that he has received a QSL for a twenty meter c.w. contact and marked: "Dairen (Peoples Republic of China).

As someone once said: "Work 'em first, worry later!". Jack Bock, K6ZR, is now worrying what the DXCC Desk will say.

There are also rumors about a callsign being issued by the Peoples Republic and operating permission having been granted. This is all interspersed with even darker rumors that some Big Gun DXers are all in on the knowledge so that they will be ready to protect their interests when the station comes on the air....

After running all of this around the track a couple of times, one must admit that it makes interesting reading...... The rumor about the BY-license refers not to LA1SH..

MACAO Reports relayed out of Hong Kong says that Horacio Torres, CR5AJ, is now in Macao and has been operating on fifteen meters signing CR9AJ. Some of the VS6-stations have been urging him to come up on twenty meters and the indicators are that this may come shortly.

IRAN EP2SN advises that he will be on every Wednesday/Thursday/Friday looking for the states and especially those states he needs to complete his WAS. Generally he will be found around 14025kc for c.w. operations and in the 14215kc-14220kc zone for SSB. Look for him from 1430Z to 1530Z.

Presently he needs Idaho/Utah/Wyoming/Montana and North Dakota. QSLs go to WA3BZA.

IRAQ W3ACE, Hank Meyer, who once signed YI2AM, was a speaker at the recent W9DXCC meeting. He reported being in Baghdad some months back and visited the top man for radio affairs there in Iraq. W3ACE mentioned the amateur radio situation.

The radio official was interested and thought that a YI-Iraq DXpedition might be possible, even a matter of good public relations. So W3ACE applied for a license to operate in Iraq.

It was rejected!!

It took a long time to get to higher authorities but definitely it was rejected. The internal feeling within Iraq is changing and the attitudes towards those from the western nations is and has changed. However, the situation at this time has not progressed sufficiently so that early activity might be expected. However, there are those who are cautiously optimistic that something may develop in the future. Practice your patience!!

EQUATORIAL GUINEA Some problems have surfaced, the main sticker being that the local contact man in Equatorial Guinea has apparently split suddenly from the local scene there leaving things a bit muddled.

If things settle down, the 3C2DX may still be heard. If the hoped for improvements do not come, it may be EA8CR all the way through the contest.....

SUNSPOT LOUIE Another week has come and gone with no significant sunspot activity. Some rain along with the cloud cover has prevented some observations but on the day of the report and the two previous days, observations were possible and they revealed nothing.

Even without the solar activity, there have been some fairly good openings on 21mc and the lower frequencies. WWV was forecasting N-6 the day of this

report and it had been N-5 the two

previous days.

WWV is forecasting an minor ionospheric storm for the period October 6th to 10th. The return to a relatively quiet status is expected to come around October 12th. While durich has revised its forecast into next year, WWV is still holding to the previous forecast.

W4UMF notes that the recent sunspot activity has been close to the splan equator which would indicate that it is tied to the cycle now ending and not to the new cycle which will come. Activity on new cycles is relatively high in latitude on the sun and tends to work down closer to the equator as the cycle comes towards its end and the start of the following cycle. WWV's semi-monthly median projection for the first half of October is for a SSN of 14.

We ran into W6TSQ the other day and asked what all of this meant. "Here fifteen meters is opening into Africa", we said; "even some ten meter stuff is showing. What does all of this mean, Sam? Son of a Gun, what do you think we got in reply. "With all this talk about spots and cycles and flux and stuff, many seem to forget that forty and eighty are wide open most days. Who cares about sunspots when you can find those fantastic conditions on the lower frequencies? Who cares?". We thought this over for a bit for what could we say but: "There you've said it again, Sam!!".

Looking ahead a bit, W4UMF kicks the great Green Computer and out comes the forecasts:

TRANSKEI REPUBLIC Things are still moving towards independence of this black homeland in South Africa and the present Transkei Parliament would be dissolved immediately after the new state celebrates its independence a year from now in October 1976.

The new country would be called the Republic of Transkei and would have a black president. The present Chief Minister of Transkei, Mr Matanzima emphasized that the new republic would never become a one-party state. It's government will be modeled along that of South Africa.

NEW COUNTRY Papua-New Guinea went independent September 15th and will join the list of deleted countries. However, it came back as a new country effective September 16th though DXCC credit will not be given until January 1st.

You will find a number of P29s listed in Red Eyed Louie this week. The whole bit of information on these changes will be in the December QST.

Newspapers recently have carried mention of 'Tuvalu' going independent. The WCDXB of September 2nd has an item by VR1AA on this. Newspaper accounts say that the new Tavalu' will have a population of about 7000 people and that the action will be taken because the Ellice Island people, who are polynesian, fear domination by the micronesian people who constitute the majority of the population in the former Gilbert and Ellice Groups. VR8 is expected to be the prefix for 'Tuvalu' come January 1st.

SHORTLY NOTED This was a week with a multitude of news and in spite of good intentions, we did not get it all together. Some that we had intended to put in this weeks bulletin will make next weeks if we get a running start. We will have to....

Last week the mailing was 1002 copies. This week it will be even more. We hve given up on any control measures..... The time is still the problem and we are not able to make complete mailings on Saturday evenings. This week we will undoubtedly have to mail some on Sunday. This is to let you know what is going on. We figure that we are getting ahead of the off-set press and everything will be downhill from here....

This is the last week we mail airmail within the U.S. We thought we could figure out how to adjust the subscriptions. Then the announcement came of another rate application which will put the postage at 13¢ just after Christmas. We are looking at adjusting the recent subscriptions but letting the older ones ride for the time being...

On the airmail, the Post Office at least in this Western Area, will combine 1st Class and Airmail for that mail headed for Canada but will keep airmail for Mexico separate from the 1st class mail. In other words, we will still continue to use airmail on the XE-subscribers but not on the VEs. Otherwise, all the other DX airmail goes the same.

FYØBHI passed through Miami last week headed for French Guiana via Puerto Rico. Ron is thinking of some DX efforts and figures he may have a couple in mind that would cause some excitedment.

CR6IK is still being heard, Will cautiously saying that the "..weather is not too good" in that area. He has already evacuated his family back to Portugal. Anyone with a good grip on how to get a A2CCY QSL....some say that the manager route is not paying off. FH8CY drew a big crowd of admirers when he showed on twenty on Sept 28th...said he would be back. 2130Z and 0800Z would seem to be the time to watch for him right on the edge of twenty phone.

Ed Berzin, WZMIG, is now the QSL Manager for VP2LL... Ed already handling 8R1CB and VP2SQ. Often he contacts his clients on the Carib Net at 7158kc, moving up to 14255kc to exchange
