# WEST COAST DX

July 6, 1976

THE WAITING GAME For sure both Bill Rindone and San Hutson were out last week and aiming to activate some rare DX but it did appear that not everything was dropping into place as hoped.

First, San Hutson, K5QHS, showed from Mayotte about June 27th and was heard over the weekend and the first part of last week. He was signing K5QHS/FH8 and this one counts for Comoro, as it has always done. Mayotte being the island that voted not to seek independence but to stay with France.

Late last week the story was that his gear had arrived at Moroni without proper custom papers, that he was seeking an audience with the President on last Thursday and hoped to get operating permission to put D6A on the air. As of Friday nothing was coming through. His plans were that if the D6A/Moroni plans did not jell, he would switch back to FL8 and seek to get Abu Ail on the air, this might be the first of this week if this one moved favorably. Initially he had indicated that he intended to sign FHØAYZ from Mayotte but apparently this was not possible.

Keep listening. Last week he was operating just above the 14200kc mark.

Bill Rindone showed up in Turkey as expected, signed WB7ABK/TA and probably ZK2AQ/TA as this was also reported. His plans called for him to be in Africa at a spot close to the equator on July 1st. This definitely would be a new one he felt if he were to get on the air and he planned to operate only on c.w. from this spot.

Last Thursday there were a lot of things going on in East Africa. There was a hi-jacked Air France jet sitting on the ramp alongside Lake Victoria in Uganda. And there was reports of revolt and street fighting in Khartoum. And generally, a conservative appraisal might say that things were in a state of 'flux'.

As Saturday was starting last weekend there had been nothing on Bill and it does appear that this one did not go. He probably will be turning up somewhere soon and more information will be coming then.

His plans, after this stop on mainland Africa, called for him to head for the Comoros and to seek the license to open from Moroni on July 7th or this Wednesday. It is possible that his plans may be changed due to developments last week but Bill definitely was aiming for a D6A operation this week. He was also planning a short stay at FH8 and hoped to be operating from a rare one in the Indian Ocean in mid-July. This definitely would be an island, the one he aimed for on July 1st was on the mainland.

That leaves WG1JFK. You should have worked it. All the signs last week were that this one would be counted for a new country once it got past the DXAC. ARRL did get a bulletin out on this one and were quite specific in saying: "...it is considered a U.S. station operating from U.S. territory".

You got the details last week. You should have heard this one over the weekend. It is also possible that a few more like this one will pop up. SUNSPOT LOUIE This ek the chart shows one area of activity on the face of the sun, this being located at 27°S. This one showed on June 23rd and had four spots covering 60 millionths of the suns surface. By the 30th it still had the two spots but was down to 40 millionths of surface.

The two spots along the equator shown on last weeks chart lasted until they turned the corner about June 25th. Also on June 25th there was a short-lived area which appeared just at about 35°W. This had disappeared by the 26th.

The high latitude areas are encouraging and better days are ahead. You should try watching the dusk to midnight transit, paths for long haul DXing transiting the dusk to midnight sector often come up with some good DX. Now there is a fairly positive statement!!

QST has another article on the situation in the July issue. This is "The Maunder Minimum" by Joe Lynch, WA6PDE, and starts on Page 24. You might also keep a watch for a new book by Ted Cohen, W4UMF, and George Jacobs, W3ASK which will be showing soon. This is reported to be titled: "An Introduction to Short Wave Radio Propagation".

In spite of periods when the patient DXers are jumping for joy, the cycle seems to still be sliding downhill and while there is joy to see signs of Cycle 21, it still appears that Cycle 20 continues to dominate things.

From now to the end of the year WWV looks for a flat SSN....looking for a SSN of '9' in July and then '8' from August through December. If this may look bad to you, it is almost unbridled optimish when you look at Dr Waldmeier's prediction for this Fall. The good doctor fromZurich says it will be "8' in July; '7' in August; '6' in September and '5' in October.

With six months of 1976 in to be cranked into the SSNs, the numbers for last Fall will look like:

June 1975	16.0 SSN	September 1975	14.5 SSN
July	15.0	October	15.6
August	14.3	November	16.3

That kink in the decline is not part of the new cycle but was due to old cycle activity. While activity from Cycle 21 is starting to be noted, the number of spots has been low. The Old Cycle sent out some spots in mid-June...June 15-22nd which was quite active....June 21st alone having a count for this action of something in the low 40's. The mean...not the SSN for May was 12.7 spots.

Now you are ready for better things....seeing that things could hardly be worse but they will be....WLUMF takes the long look into the fugure and finds some HNS!!!!

special call from a Boy Scout ~ mboree in Lagos for SHORTLY NOTED 5N2BSJ will be two weeks from August 28th. QSLs will go to Box 448, Apapa, agos, Nigeria.

OE5GML/YK has replaced OE6DK on the Golan Heights. VS6AW, now in Teheran, has been waiting for a license and EP2VW is anticipated ..... shortly.

UAØOAA is looking for Wyoming/North Dakota and Mississippi for WAS. Often at or about 14025kc from 1500Z. VR8A will be leaving Tuvalu on August 12th. At this time he says it would be best to QSL to his home QTH .... ZL2BJU.

K6YNB will be trying some moonbounce/meteor scatter from Alaska from about August 11th. He will be in Ketchikan on August 10th, figuring to be on the air the following day. He will try the Perseids Meteor shower on 144mhz, switching for moonbounce to 432mhz about August 18th. This is an effort supported by the Northern California DX Foundation.

On the SP6-effort aimed at Iraq now seems to be aimed at September. Hubert Trzaska, SP6RT, was delayed and now will be visiting in the U.S. and in Canada in the coming months. One stop will be at the Conference on Precision Electromagnetic measurements at the Bureau of Standards in Boulder, Colorado. Another stop will be at Ottawa at the Internation Conference on Medical Physics. In between he will be visiting at some universities. As of late June, Bert was figuring that the earliest that anything might come would be early September.

The Postal Service is thinking about raising rates again. Last week the report was that when the 13¢ postage rate goes 'permanent', which will be when the Postal Rate Commission makes a decision on the 'temporary' increases. A maximum allowable new 'temporary' rate would bring first-class up around 17¢ per ouch .....

VR3AH looking still to be on forty and eighty before long. UKØKAA is on Wrangel Island in the Arctic Ocean. This used to count as a country.....no one ever worked it when it did. Soupy Groves, W5NW, was visiting with VK2AVA last week...on SSB 14246/1230Z.

K40SE is the QSL route for WB6EWH/VQ9. New officers of the Northern California DX Club are: President, Orm Meyer, K6QX; Vice President Richard Lawton, K6QZ, and Henry Davis, K6IXS and Rod Deakin, WA6CVU, fill out the roster of officers. 3D6BH QSLs may be a bit more successful if sent to Box 14, Manzini, Swaziland. Often K3KLE is given as the QSL manager... the problem being that K3KLE is still in Africa. The 3D6BH QSL card itself says to go to W3KOD. If you do not connect with 5X5NK by the direct route, one via DL1YW might do the job as the QSL Manager arrangements seem to be on again. 9Q5DM is presently in the States and at Harvard....this is 905DM-John. South African sources say that another operation is keeping the station going.

While there seems to be scant hope that the Goldwater/Vanik measures on RFI will ever survive, it might be a time to take a worried look at the future. In forty-seven states there is at least one community, often more, where there are laws which allow the municipalities to fine radio operators who cause interference. One CB type in Texas was fined \$100 for causing TVI. It may do little good to say that Federal law preempts this area as it will cause you to spend a bundle to find out whether you are right or not.

Two-Letter Calls The ARRL has available a list of the two letter calls available as of June 15th. You can get the list by sending a business size envelope, No.10, with 24¢ postage to the ARRL. The information was copied direct from the FCC records in Washington.

6 July 1976

If you are in the Extra Class now and were licensed 25 years ago, you can apply for an available two-letter call as of July 1st .... last Thursday. The next step will be for those licensed before November 22, 1967. They can apply October 1st for any two-letter call available, that date of November 22nd being the date by which they were in the Extra Class.

On January 1, 1977 those in the Extra Class before July 1st of 1974 can apply. Then it will be those in Extra Class before July 1, 1976 and they can apply as of April 1, 1977. Then on July 1, 1977 anyone obtaining the Extra Class after July 1, 1976 can apply.

In some areas a surprising number of two letter calls are available. The 4th and 6th District have the fewest available, while some districts such as the 1st, 3rd, 5th. 9th and 10th will have a good supply. Surprisingly, in the 9th District it appears that but four two-letter calls beginning with 'K' hve been issued and a lot of the 'W' are still available .... comparatively speaking.

It takes FCC Form 610, photocopy of present license, proof of first license or Extra date. \$25.00 for the special call, \$3.00 for modification or \$4.00 for renewal and you mail it all to FCC, Box 1020, Gettysburg, Penna 17325. Applicants will be processed on a first-come basis.

Silent Key two-letter calls are available for reassignment. You have to prove that they are silent, however.

SHORTLY NOTED STUFF KITZQ has over half the QSLs for VK2FT/Lord Howe in the mails. Howie looks to see them all cleaned up and current sometime this week. He is also still looking for anyone with information on KW6H0....For QSL purposes, of course. VR3AA heard a week back had a lot of suspicious factors .... when asked about QSLing there was a lot of unintelligible information. More than one wondering on this one. W9ZNY who is often at BV2B says to looking for the station from 2300-24COZ on Saturdays. W9ZNY will try to get the activity going at 1100Z when he returns there later this month.

Geoff Watts reports that it appears but two G-stations worked the 7J1RL. In Holland VERON says that only PAØGMW saved the honor of the Deserving Dutch DXers .....


