GALALAPAGOS ISLANDS A major effort from HC8 will be staged by a group of HC-amateurs, the operation to run around the clock from September 16th to 23rd. The group will be on Santa Cruz Island and will be staying at the Hotel Galapagos which is owned by HC8FN.

Those participating in the effort will be:

A multitude of call-signs will be used. For the group operation, a special prefix has been authorized and this is HDSCD. The 'CD' suffix is to honor Charles Darwin who spent time in the islands a few years back aboard the HMS Beagle and from his studies there developed his theories on natural selection in evolution.

A special award will go to the <u>first</u> station to work HC8CD via OSCAR 7 and this will commemorate the first QSO with the Galapagos-via-satellite. Diplomas will go to those who manage to work HD8CD on all bands....regardless of mode. And when they say all band, they mean one-sixty through ten and OSCAR 7.

The group have all their airline reservations confirmed, the hotel reservations confirmed and everything looks like a downhill slide.

Gear will include a KW-2000B on one-sixty...and Collins, Kenwood, Drake, Heath and Atlas rigs. A choice of KW linears will help on eighty through ten. For 10/15/20 there will be a couple of tri-bander: yagis and for OSCAR 7 it will be a KLM Multi-2700 running into a 5-element yagi.

HD8CD will go to WA8TDY/K8LJG for North and South Ameria and Asia...and SWLs in these continents. QSLs from Europe, Africa and SWLs in these continents will go to IØWDX

Those applying for the 7-mode OSCAR awards will send their list to Rick Dorsch, HC5EE, Box 665, Cuenca, Ecuador.

SUNSPOT LOUIE There has been a lot of activity since the sun was last charted, with a string of active press along or about 20°N. Last week we had but No. 861, a large active area. It continued to go down a bit but was still the largest thing around when it turned the corner at the western limb on August 16th.

No. 862 showed on August 10th at 22°S and lasted but E one day with its one spot/10 millionths. No. 863 E showed on August 11th at 17°S and turned the corner the following day....one spot/20 millionths

No. 864 showed on August 12th....Nos 865/866/867/868 and 869 showed on August 15th. Something is definitely trying to help the Deserving DXer.

Up to this burst of activity, many were wondering why the activity on Cycle 21 to date has been so low. This November will be three years since the first spots from Cycle 21 were observed. While it is not unusual to have the two cycles mix for a year or so, here it is three years almost and things have not yet been lined out for the good days that the DXers have been promised.

The flux continues to edge well up into the 80s and there is yet basis for hope. Sometimes hope may be all you have but keep it up....you will get what you deserve...yet.

And with N4XX keeping the hopes for some HNs but finding 60 millionths a few LNs and BNs in the nest, we look all the way up to the coming Labor Day Weekend and we find that LNs are promised....but that will be an improvement over the BNs that will have been around. And looking down the sad days of August and into the sad days of September, N4XX says it will be something like....

Observers at Kitt Peak Observatory say that geomagnetic storms can be predicted by watching the appearance of holes in the solar corona. The increased solar wind passing the earth about a week after the appearance of the holes brings an increase in charged particles and this causes disturbances in the geomagnetic field. The feeling is that regular observations with the Solar Vacuum Telescope at Kitt Peak will enable a weeks warning of the occurrence of geomagnetic storms.

SHORTLY NOTED Last week we got all the bulletin into the mails on Saturday. That's two weeks in a row that we got the second-class going on Saturday and the problems with delivery have eased. We are adjusting our work routine for more of a start on Wednesday and this should hopefully solve all the problems....

There have been a number of peculiar calls noted but with the rash of variants on prefixes and suffixes ; showing, it is hard to figure out which is the true-blue and which is Slim. Work them all....and recently drawing some attention was TF4F....which was good. And there was 4Z190S to mark the tenth anniversary of something in Israel. But the wonder of them all has to be that 4079WARC which showed during the WAE Test. This may be good but we would like to know where...

The VB3IAT was the 150th Anniversary of Toronto...QSLs to VE3IAT. HVØPB said to QSL to the Vatican. This was true-blue Slim. KA6PS worked this one...and wondered. The next night he talked with IØCUT and IØGPY in Rome and they got Brother Ed on frequency from HV3CJ. Brother Ed advised that no such call had been issued by"the Vatican." IH9HLO from Pantelleria...this actually should be listed with the African reports as it is within the continental limits as decided by the WAZ people some years back....if our memory is still holding up. Should count for Zone 34.

As long as we are on the subject...and to head off any pointed remarks, that JA7/JD1 should be listed with the Asians...we got to thinking of Marcus and slipped Ogasawara in the wrong place. Marcus is in Oceania...Zone 27. IH9HLO goes to I2YBC.

VKØAC says that QSLs will go out around Christmas time. Some continue to ask about PYØZAE QSLs. The very latest word...last Friday....is that Hal says the cards will be received from the printer any day now and cards should be going in the mails by this Friday. PY7PS says that he has been talking with Hal about the cards and will be visiting him their in Rio soon to see if he can help. We would like to hear when anyone gets is PYØZAE QSL. As has been noted before, most everything comes to he who waits....long enough. And there is hope that your PYØZAE will be in your hot hand before long.

There are still some ripples from the Guatemalan earthquake emergency some months back and apparently one of the adapted that continue to pop up on that emergency was whether the Guatemalan government ever declared 14205ko an emergency frequency for handling traffic. WhIR points out that this was never done. Ham says that the frequency was used by a newspaper to transmit copy to a Florida newspaper, however.

On the supply of IRCs that Gordon Fogg, WB500E/N5AU had for sale....he had about a few over a thousand and they went in three days after the notice came out in the bulletin. Gordon says that he will advise when he has another supply but for now he is clean! Experience indicates that unless you have about 3000 IRCs on hand when you announce a garage sale, you are going to be cleaned out in short order.

WB500E/N5AU along with WDMAA and K5JA will be active from VP2C-Grenada for the CQ WW SSB Test and very likely the CW Test. Starting the lst of October we would like to be advised of plans for any special DX operations for the CQ WW SSB Test....and from November 1st for any CQ WW CW Test. We like those long lists to make the search easier. As one of the local QRPers said at the Thursday Old Fogey Luncheon t this week...."... why anyone can work DXCC over a contest weekend. If you have a big antenna system, a full kilowayt and a good location......for starters." We still think that it may take a bit of doing but it is possible....at least the local QRPer says so.

WB5HVY is looking to close out his manager duties on KJ6DL. Floyd would like to get inquiries from anyone who may want a card....guarantees one-day service when sase/IRC sent. KJ6DL now KH6DL and will be there in Hawaii for some years. TJ1BB often shows around 14285kc from 2100Z for a list operation with 9G1KP. It helps to know that the list is often assembled the previous day. A6XP dropped in to visit Father Dave at CEØAE, Bodo was on vacation and will be back in the United Emirates in mid-September.

AUSTRALIAN ANTARCTIC An Australian government agency has recommended that Australia make a study of prospective petroleum geology in several areas of the sub-Antarctic.

Some of the areas to be studied included the Kerguelen Plateau in the sub-Antarctic waters off Macquarie Island.....800 miles south of Tasmania and the Lord Howe ridge and the Norfolk Island ridge off eastern Australia.

The whole thing stems from an attempt to improve the situation for reserves of petroleum in Australia. A well is planned near Campbell Island. Australia has also made geological surveys in the vicinity of Heard Island.

Hunt Petroleum out of New Zealand is presently trying a well drilling operation near Campbell Island. Some of these remote islands with little more than weather stations located on them may find a bit more activity in the coming years. Some of the areas listed should stir some DXers to a bit of hope.

KERMEDEC The New Zealand group has a Lister diesel generator....1.75kva...and plans are firming up for the long planned Kermedec operation in October.

Present planning calls for a departure from New Zealand on October 16th and an arrival in the Kermedec group on October 20th. They will operate through November 4th and plan to depart the islands on November 5th.

This schedule should put them right across the WW CQ DX Test on the Oct 29/30th weekend. The latest report is that ZL1EKL has the necessary permits just about lined out and everything is apparently falling into place.

ISLANDS OF THE WORLD Whidbey Island (Washington) amateurs are sponsoring a new award. The rules are quite extensive and you can get them by sending a same to:
