There may be more. A H5TND was also reported as a possibility. The group will try all possible bands from One-sixty to OSCAR. They were insisting last week that they want to operate on all the bands all the time.

Last week VE3FXT was in Lesotho. There may be more information next week but things were definitely shaping up for this possible new one over the Thanksgiving holiday. For those who worry about modes, that H5VCM (K9VCM) prefers to work c.w. over any other mode. ZSLMG will also be found on c.w.

There should be a lot of noise when this one comes on the line. You have a week to warm up. Always remember what Lord Baden-Powell, the Hero of Mafeking, would say in such situations...... Be Prepared!!

LI2B Thor Heyerdahl, who has been heard from on rafts before, is afloat in the Persian Gulf area on a reef raft named the "TIGRIS". The launching spot was at the town of Qurna where the Tigris and Euphrates join. There is no definite destination, the object being to see how far towards, or into the Indian Ocean, such a vessel might make it.

The vessel was heard at 14200kc at 1200Z on November 12th calling for some east coast stations on an apparent schedule. W2KGO and WB2BEE were on frequency but could not hear the expecition station. KP4EKI and KZ5FR did succeed in working LI2B on that day.

The station has been heard since, last Wednesday it was under a tremendous pile-up. The operator is Norm Baker and it is reported that he had a one-time authorization to operate from with Iraqi territory. The raft probably should be in the Persian Gulf by this time.....

SUNSPOT LOUIE Conditions still are rising in Cycles hardly the fast rise in the SSN that was hoped for.

The activity this week has three areas of light activity and one large area. We will be moving into the period of good conditions that existed in early November and you might be alert.

The twelve-month Smoothed Sunspot Number centered on April 1977 was 22.0.

It might be timely to again note that the cycle is defined by the variations in the twelve month running socothed sunspot numbers. It is not determined by the monthly mean for sunspots.

The monthly mean for about now has been getting into the forties. However, these figures, the monthly mean, refer only to the month in question, the smoothed number is derived from the 12-month figure.

St PIETRO/St. PAOLO CHERADI ISLANDS 'A formal request to the ARRL DXCC Desk to count this group as a separate DXCC country has been forwarded by Giampaolo Nucciotti, ISKDB, the Award Manager of the Associazione Radiotecnica

There was activity from these islands early this year, I7JEX being heard from July 22nd to August 2nd. There was a special call, IJ70NU, used on July 28th to mark the ARI-UNICEF Day. Since the original operation the prefix IJJ has been permanently assigned to the islands.

The islands are in the Gulf of Taranto in the Ionian Sea, 40°27'N and 17°9'E. The request for DXCC country status is based on criteria of a separate and distinct administration. They islands are under the authority of the Italian Navy Department of the Ministry of Defense. Most other territory in Italy is administered by the Department of Interior.

The papers and letter on this request went to the ARRL DXCC Desk in late October. It probably will be some months before any action comes on this request.

K3AO, WLNL and KLFJ are going to put Delaware on OSCAR 7, Mode A, on December 11th and will aim for Orbits 14055, 14056, 14059 and 14060. The downlink frequency will be 29490kc, plus or minus doppler.

The callsign to be used is K3AO/3. Delaware is a rare one on OSCAR and this will be an effort to dry up some of the demand. A one day effort a week from this coming Sunday.

This comes as a recommendation of the Bureau International de l'Heure (BIH) in Paris.

Dennis McCluskey, WBLIWW, is handling the QSLs for TR8MFB and the logs for the first few days of this Gabon operation are already in his hands. The first QSLs have already gone out, this batch of logs running up to October 15, 1977. TR8MFB has received some QSLs direct but has not cards there with him. WBLIWW is shipping some over but this will be a slow route for a QSL.

Leo Haijsman, WhKA, is handling the QSLs for C6ABC on during the CQ WW Phone Test in October and also for 5W1AB. Sase or Sae/Irc needed.

VQ1BC was on twenty meters recently and said he was on Raoma Island off Zanzibar. From Florida the beam heading was 180°..., the normal path for Zanzibar would be 83°. Down in the Falklands a VP8 found them coming in at 0°. the VQ1 said he was from HB9 and would be there a couple of months. Was at 14210kc/0455Z.

Then there was ZA5FB from Downtown Tirana at 14013kc/1125Z on November 18th. What does all of this prove? Only that the Great Days of DXing are with us....and you might as well work them first and worry later because sooner or later you will learn that Slim is everywhere. He started as 8X8A from Cray Island and has been on a continuous DXpedition since then. Often QSOed....seldomed QSLed!

 MORE SHORTLY NOTED The early operations from Juan Fernandez by Dr Austin Regal and Bill Poellmitz brought a strong signal from their operating position. CEØZM should have produced a big total of QSOs during the CW WW CW TEST this last weekend.

Though NAWW and K1MM would like to make a San Felix—CEØX stop, it was not feasible on this trip. While in Santiago a week back, they were checking into possible arrangements for transportation for some future planning.

QSLs for the CEØZM operations....as well as CEØZD......can go to Dr. Regal at P.O. Box 11882, Orlando, Florida 32857. Any items that come their way in the way of support for the Juan Fernandez operation will be used to get a San Felix operation on the tracks.

PYØZAE QSLs continue to come in....always finding a delighted one at the receiving end. During recent weeks there appeared to be nothing but JY7s out of Joruan. Red Eyed came up with eleven different active ones.

3C1X from Equatorial Guinea continues to be reported but not with all the numbers of the early operation. He is supposed to be there for some weeks yet. Band conditions were not especially good before the Test last weekend and this probably has cut down on some of the activity.

TU2GA says that he is often on from 0640Z on Six Meters. The two frequencies for 6mtrs in the Ivory Coast are 50.05mHz and 50.95mHz. TU2GH says that he has been working ZLs on the short path on Six. He also says he has been work 6W8AK on two meters...this about a 900 mile haul and has been doing it regularly.

ARRL notes that YV5ZZ and LU1DAU managed a two-meter contact without the use of satellites or EME. This amounted to a 3135 mile QSO on two meters. It took two years of scheduling and broke the old record of 2540miles set by W6NLZ and KH6UK back in 1957.

W5UFF tried both direct and via DL7FT for a QSL for FC9UC. Got them both ways though one route was just a bit faster.

The ZLs who put on the successful Kermedec operation say that QSLs will be coming out in January. It looks about sixty more days at this time but they are moving to get them back to the Deserving.

VEHACY who used to be A2CCY has found the temperature in Winnipeg down to −15°C. Bob never found anything like that in Botswana and thinks of those days of other years when he was warm.

There is a report that Erik, SMØAGD, is back in Sweden from his latest trip to the SouthEast Asia and Middle East places.

The W7PHO Cathering continues to draw in a lot of DX. In mid-November a quick check showed 9M8/9M2/KC6/CR9 and a number of other semi-rare ones checking in regularly. The Africana Net at 21355kc from sometime after 1700Z is attracting a lot of the Africans including ZDs.

There continue to be rumors about possible South Sandwich operations. Like a lot of other things, a South Sandwich operation will come some day....but not soon enough.

As far as we can recall, there has been only the original LU-operation from South Sandwich which brought it DXCC status, and the VP8 operation a few years later. The logistics for a South Sandwich operation are formidable and it is doubtful if there will be any activity unless it hitches a ride on some large naval vessel....or research vessel....going there for other reasons. Ships do operate in the vicinity of the group and there are occasional landings on some of the islands. But do not look for someone...on the spur of the moment....to jump into their little of boat and head out to put South Sandwich on the air. It most likely will not happen that way and there should be sufficient advance information. There are a lot of amateurs in that part of the world who would like to find the opportunity to activate that one...

Some will find in their Atlas the South Sandwich Group listed at 57°S and 25°W. They are strung out over some distance. South Georgia is at 54°15'S and 36°45'W. Definitely south of the Roaring Forties and well into the Furious Fifties.

The ARRL, noting the problems with court cases involving interference and zoning problems that some amateurs are coping with, authorized the use of the unallocated funds from the Minute 60 action of the July 1976 Board Meeting to be used in helping with these cases.

There is also a report of two amateurs in the Louisiana country being convicted in court for obscenity and interference to a repeater.
