

All members must have confirmations of two-way communication with a minimum of 25 countries, based on the ARRL Countries List. Each member must be a member of ARRL. He has been heard off the Chinese coast, in Alaska, Canal Zone, Hawaii and Australia. On 50 watts input there is used 1,000 volts A.C. on the plate, 10 volts A.C. on the filament and draws about 110 milliamperes.

Do these radio call letters bring back memories to Point Richmond natives? The late Charles Henry was from a pioneer Point Richmond family that lived on Glenn Street. He was a radio engineer working for the old KLX radio station in Oakland in the 1930's. At his home he had a huge ham radio station, W6EJA, that could reach many countries in the world. We were always thrilled to listen to him communicate with people in Australia, New Zealand, Panama and other countries.

Charlie Henry was the envy of the Point baseball players and fans as he was the radio engineer for the announcer who broadcasted the home games from Oakland to San Francisco. Charlie sailed for a short time in the Merchant Marine as a radio operator, mostly on Lumber Steam Schooners.





The USS Hoel was sunk during the Battle Off Samar on October 25, 1944 and had only 89 survivors of the 342 crew.






Other calls heard at my home in Oakland included **W61T** (“I, Indiana, T, Texas”), **Jack Tait**; **W6TT** (“T as in this, T as in that, or, alternatively, “T, tonsillitis, T, tuberculosis”), **Elvin Fiege**; **W6DUB**, (“the dub station in Oakland”), **Mario Chirone**. ELvin and MARio later acquired Electric Supply Company where I at times had purchased the few parts and receiving tubes I could afford for my limited radio projects. ELMAR Electronics operated by these hams did well, ultimately being sold by them to Wylie Laboratories now in Santa Clara.








XU8RA 1940 China


